Deacon's Corner

We Are To Be One With the Most Holy Trinity

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! This doctrine of our faith is not specifically defined merely in Holy Scripture; rather, the Holy Trinity is made known through the Sacred Traditions, Scriptures, and Teachings of our Church. It is most certainly a Mystery, but that does not mean we cannot understand something about it, only that we will not be able to fully comprehend and understand it completely in this life. Today's readings provide some insights and reveal a little bit of what we know as the Most Holy Trinity by showing us some aspects of who God is.

In the First Reading from Exodus, God recommit himself to the Covenant with Israel, giving Moses two stone tablets of the Law (the Ten Commandments) and telling Moses his personal name. Even though the Israelites had repeatedly sinned against God, and even worshipped idols made of gold, God's love is far surpassing of their sins, and he reveals himself as a "merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity."

In our Second Reading from Paul to the Corinthians, Paul has been dealing with many and various problems at the Church in Corinth. The part of the letter we hear today is at the end of his Second Letter to them. Here too, Paul reveals that God is a god of "love and peace," and that if we live according to our faith in Jesus Christ, we also will be able to become love and peace to each other. He then blesses the community with the grace of Jesus, the love of the Father, and the communion and fellowship of the Holy Spirit.

Finally, in our Gospel, John reveals the incredible depth of God's love for us. God the Father sent his Son Jesus, not to condemn the world, but to save us through his ministry, suffering, death, and resurrection. The love of the Father is so far beyond our comprehension, but all we must do is accept this love by accepting and believing in his Son, receiving the grace he offers, allowing him to be ruler of our lives, and living as true followers, disciples, of Jesus Christ.

What is most characteristic in these descriptions is LOVE. In a very real sense, this is the essence of the Most Holy Trinity, the unity of Three Persons as One God in love. God the Father completely empties himself, and gives himself entirely to his Son. God the Son, also completely empties himself, likewise entirely giving himself to his Father. And the love shared in this self-emptying and self-giving perpetual act is in fact, the Holy Spirit.

We are not able to completely give ourselves to God, to completely empty ourselves of our desires, so that we desire nothing except that God's will acts in us, that our actions and God's will are one and the same. As we approach a complete emptying of our desires, God is able to fill us with his grace, the grace to become Saints. And that is the essence and purpose of our life, to become one with God himself, to find our unity in the Most Holy Trinity itself.

God is one, and we are called to be one with him. Let us consider the things in our lives, our personal desires, the attachments we have to this world, our egos, and even our pains, to see what is keeping us from totally giving ourselves to God. If we are able to empty ourselves of these things, God will fill them with his grace, giving us his peace, goodness, and love, and we will be able to become that peace, goodness, and love to each other, and in our world.

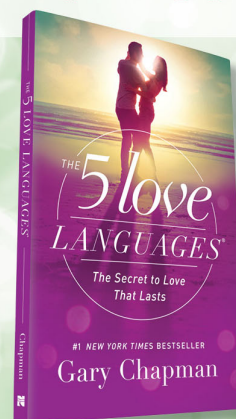
