Deacon's Corner

What Are You Afraid Of?

Statistics tell us that 20-25% of us have some form of mental illness in any given year. The vast majority of those experiencing mental illness suffer from anxiety or an anxiety-related disorder, but sadly, only a fraction of people receives proper treatment. Unfortunately, mental illness still carries a stigma, and no one wants to be labeled with any one of a number of negative names. According to Psychiatrist Dr. Hilde Bruch, in her book Learning Psychotherapy, the basis for those seeking treatment is fear! She writes that this fear leads us to become convinced that we are helpless and unable to either cope with our life situations or change them. Whether we experience fear of abandonment, fear of death, fear for our children, fear of life, fear of not being able to provide for our family, fear of illness, fear of commitment – no matter what the fear may be – the spiritual solution to rise above our fears is found in love. Specifically, it is the love of Jesus that will raise us up from the pit of fear – Jesus, who IS love incarnate, who is love itself.

In today's Gospel, we are reminded three times not to be afraid. That same Gospel also tells us that the reason we do not need to fear is because we have a loving Father who knows all about us, more than we even know about ourselves, and that his love for us is greater than any power or circumstance life can throw at us. Jesus says, "Even the hairs on your head are counted." The smallest of details, even those no one else sees, God knows, and knowing all things about us, God loves us more than we can even love ourselves. His love, mercy, and forgiveness surpass everything, every situation, every pain, and every need. His love is infinite, and he only asks that we trust him and abandon ourselves to his loving care, like a small child who fearlessly curls up in the arms of his mother, somehow knowing that her love provides protection and safety, that her arms are like wings of an angel, shielding him from all harm.

We all know people, or perhaps, we are ourselves, suffering from some degree of mental illness, whether it be anxiety, depression, or some other condition. Recognizing that fear is somehow related to these conditions, and is perhaps the basis of them, let us meditate on Jesus' call to us to not be afraid. These were favored words of Saint John Paul II, "Do not be afraid." Let us realize this message in our own lives and then take it to those in our world, take it with the love of Christ. Love is the key to unlocking the grip of fear in our lives, and as Christians, we are called to evangelize our world, starting with our families and friends, with the love of our Heavenly Father. Find something in your life that you can turn over to God today, and then begin living life with less fear as you allow the loving arms of our Father to embrace you.
