Several parishioners have called the parish office to ask if this Thursday, May 26, 2022, is a holy day of obligation. In our diocese, the Ascension of the Lord is transferred to Sunday, May 29, 2022. Please see the note below taken from the Diocese of Palm Beach website.

Note: In the archdioceses and dioceses within the Ecclesiastical Provinces of Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Omaha, and Philadelphia, the Ascension of the Lord always falls on Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter and is a Holy Day of Obligation. In all other archdioceses and dioceses, the Ascension of the Lord is transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter.

We have started painting the church.

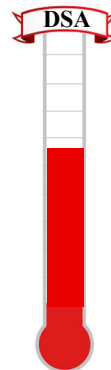

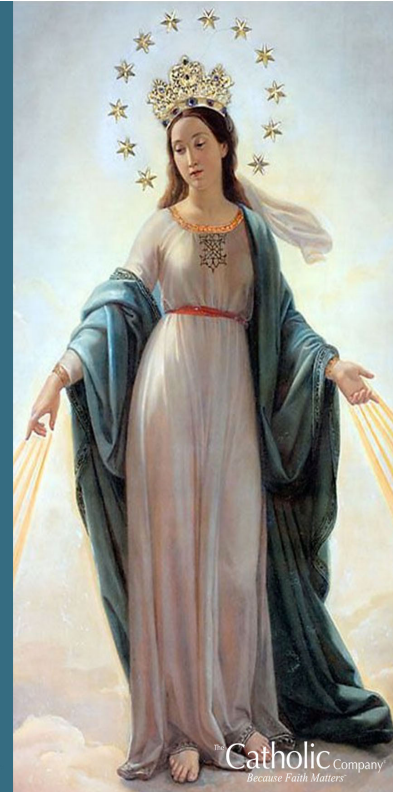

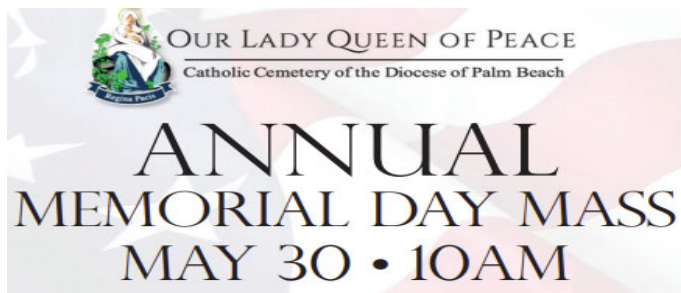
Guest Speaker & Second Collection **NEXT WEEKEND** **May 28 and 29**
