

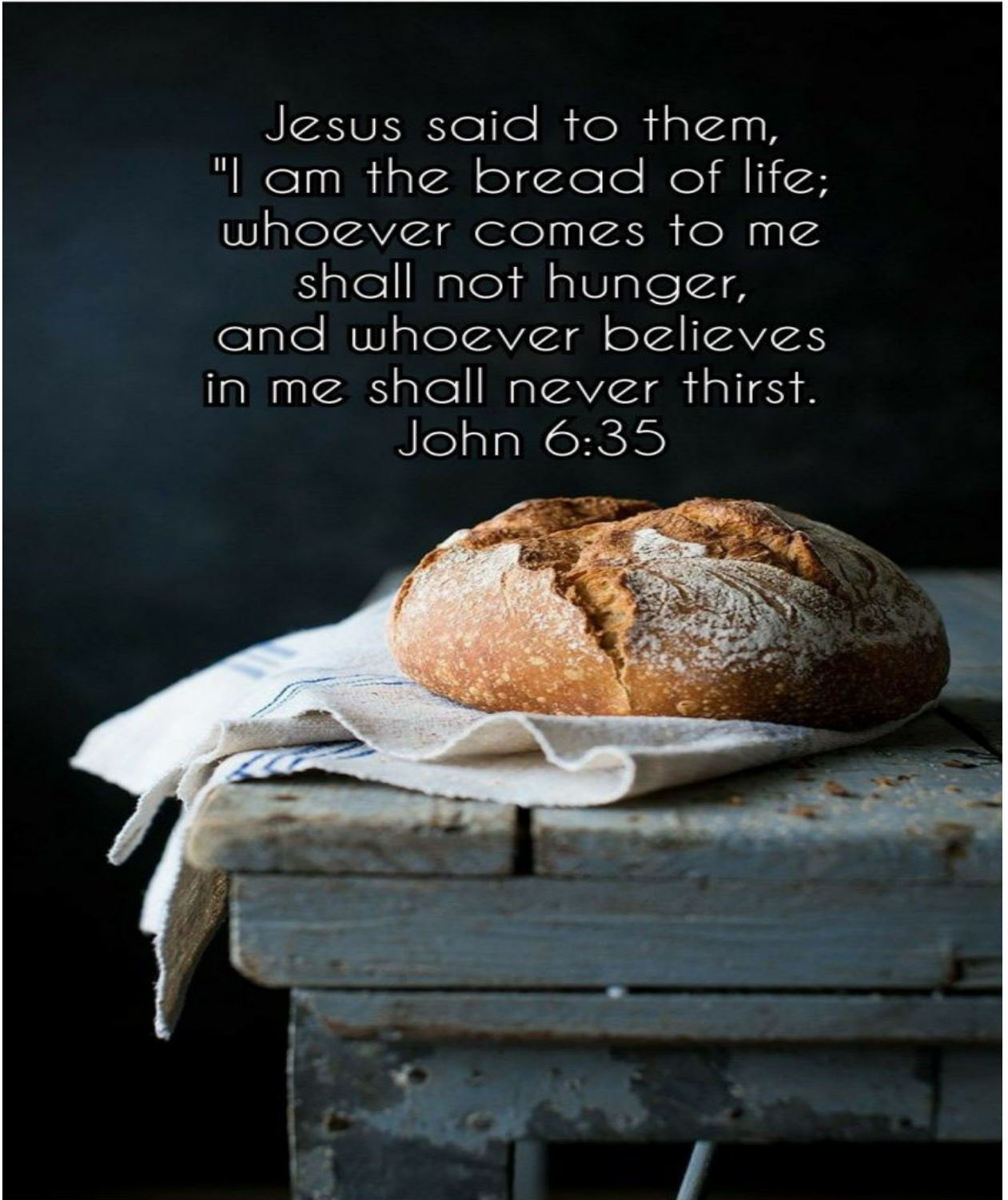

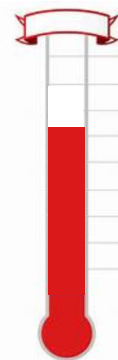

Please join us as we share a meal, enjoy fellowship, give praise and encourage one another in our faith journey. Our guest speaker is Fr. Brian Flanagan, pastor emeritus of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Palm Beach Gardens. Fr. Brian grew up as a cradle Catholic in a family of eight children. His parents Jack and Harriet sent their children to Catholic school through college. They prayed the rosary nightly as a family and were involved in parish activities. In many ways they were a typical Catholic family of the 1950's. Fr Brian from the age of five wanted to become a priest and actually contacted the Maryknoll Missionaries in 8th grade about attending the high school seminary. They advised him to attend regular high school and stay in touch. Fr Brian was in high school from 1962-1966, during Vatican II. He attended college from 1966-1970, the Vietnam War era. When he finished his education, he wasn't sure what we believed anymore, so much had changed. He never stopped praying but became an occasional Mass attendee. In the 1980's, while teaching at South Tech in Boynton Beach, a friend had the opportunity to go on pilgrimage to Medjugorje. She asked Fr. Brian if he would like her to ask the Blessed Mother anything for him; sarcastically he said, "Ask her what God wants from me." He learned not to ask the Blessed Mother anything you don't want to know. Come and join us to hear the rest of the story.

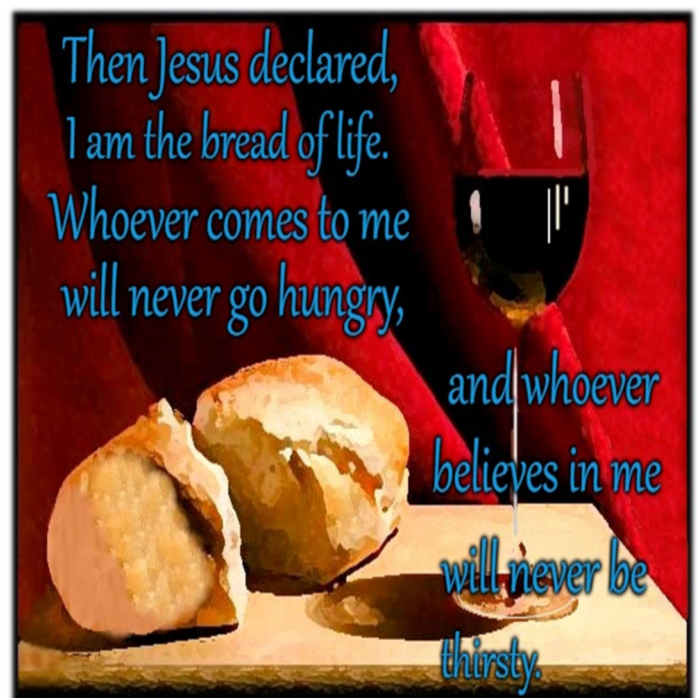

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

On August 7 and 8, our Diocese will have a second collection to benefit two areas of need: the Church in Latin America and the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa. The funds collected next weekend will be split between these two important areas and allow us to join in unity to support these communities outside of the United States.

For more than 50 years, the collection for the Church in Latin America has been an expression of unity and solidarity between Catholics in the United States and those in Latin America and the Caribbean. Catholics like you, from across the United States, have supported the formation of priests and religious, the training of catechists and other pastoral ministers, the education of children and young people, and relief efforts in the wake of natural disasters in this area. Next weekend's collection supports many pastoral projects that benefit the faithful in Latin America and the Caribbean, plus it allows you to stand in closer unity with refugees and those serving them.

The Solidarity Fund for the Church of Africa supports those who still lack access to basic resources and pastoral care. Your donation specifically supports pastoral projects to build the capacity of the Church and foster lasting peace and reconciliation in a continent often marked by division and tension. As the Church in Africa grows, the pastoral needs of the people also increase. From the formation of clergy to communications programs that bring the Gospel to remote territories to youth ministries that engage the next generation of disciples, the Church's needs are wide-ranging. The Solidarity Fund is an opportunity for our diocese to stand with the people of Africa.

Because of your generosity, our brothers and sisters in Latin America, the Caribbean and Africa will have the opportunity to grow in faith and answer the call of God. Through your financial gifts, as well as your prayerful remembrance, we join as one family of faith in making the Gospel of Jesus Christ known around the world.

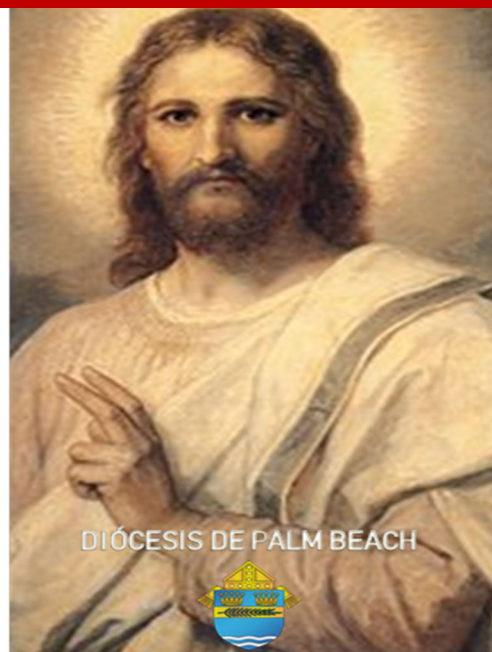

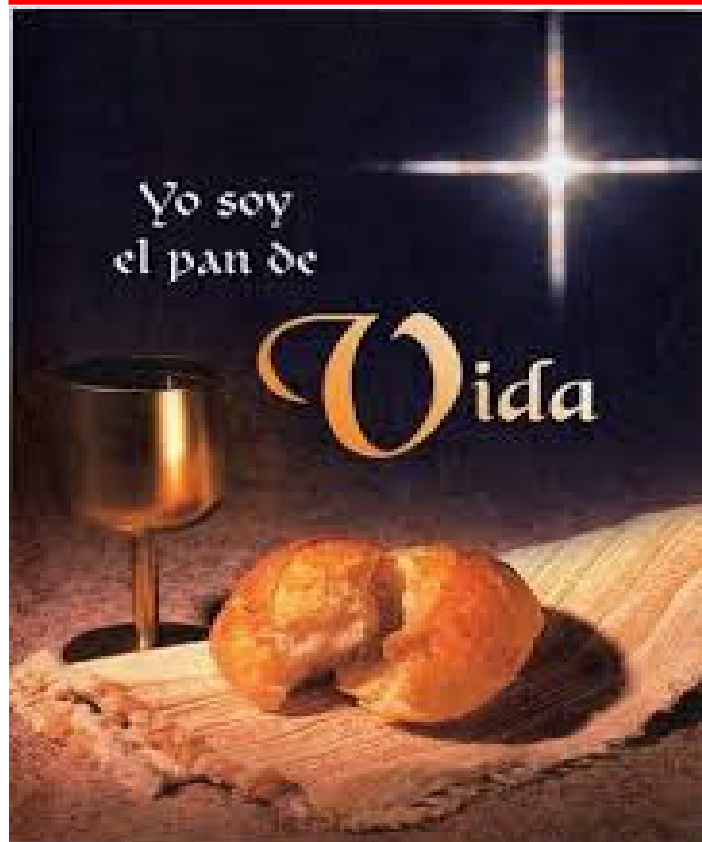
