2016 Diocesan Services Appeal—"We've been Called"

We want to thank you for your generosity in supporting our Diocese and Bishop Barbarito in our 2015 Diocesan Services Appeal. As you know the support of all the parishes throughout the diocese funds all their necessary activities and good works. Although we did not meet our goal, we did raise more funds for the Appeal than ever before. Once again it's that time of year where we begin our new appeal and our new commitment was \$217,000. After meeting with the Diocese and discussing our hard work and commitment to the Diocese, the Bishop approved a recommendation from the DSA Advisory Committee to not only reduce our goal to \$180,000 for 2016 but also to forgive our 2015 shortfall which as you can see below is \$32,543. (Assuming everyone fulfills their pledge). We are very grateful to the Committee and the Bishop for all their support and we truly trust that we will achieve our goal of \$180,000 in 2016!

The Season of Lent begins in ten days! Sr. Joan Chittister, OSB, in her pamphlet for Lent entitled "MERCY," writes "Lent is a time to weep for what we could have been and are not. Lent is the grace to grieve for what we should have done and did not. Lent is the opportunity to change what we ought to change but have not. Lent is not about penance. Lent is about becoming, doing and changing whatever it is that is blocking the fullness of life in us right now...We are all required to do our best to bring about the reign of God in our time. We are not here simply to wait for heaven. We are here to bring it."

Pope Francis said that the season of Lent during this Holy Year of Mercy "should be lived more intensely as a privileged moment to celebrate and experience God's mercy." To assist us in "becoming, doing, and changing." Sr. Joan offers us a different mantra for each week of Lent. Consider repeating it a number of times each day. Carry the mantra in your heart all day long.

Week One Mantra: *Our God is kind and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in mercy.* - Psalm 103:8

Week Two Mantra: *Mercy and truth shall embrace; justice and peace shall kiss.* - Psalm 85:10

Week Three Mantra: *Be patient with all things, but most of all with yourself.*
St. Francis de Sales.

Week Four Mantra: *God is mercy within mercy within mercy.* -
Thomas Merton.

Week Five Mantra: *Be merciful as your God in heaven is merciful* -
Luke 6:56.

Week Six Mantra: *By the tender mercy of God the morning sun will rise upon us.* - Luke 1:78

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

Boys: dress pants, white or light color dress shirt, tie, dress shoes & socks (no sandals, flip-flops, sneakers).

Girls: modest white or light colored dress, or skirt (no low-cut, mini or floor length) or dress slacks w. modest top, dress shoes or dress sandals (no flip-flops or sneakers).

Sponsors:

Men: dress shirt, tie, dress pants, (sport coat or suit optional but appropriate), dress shoes & socks (no sandals, flip-flops, sneakers).

Women: Modest dress or skirt (no mini lengths) or dress slacks and modest top, dress shoes or dress sandals (no flip-flops, sneakers).

Etiquette: Maintain sanctity of the occasion. Respect others in prayer. Refrain from talking before/during the Mass.

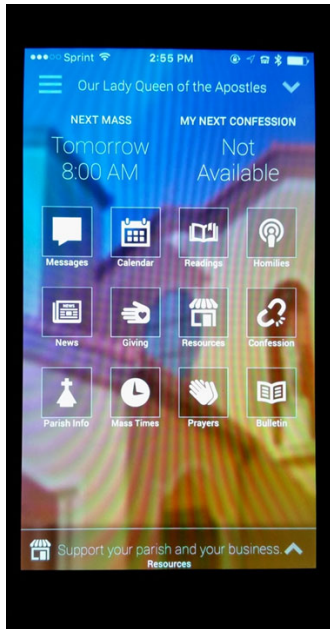

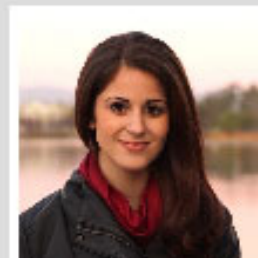

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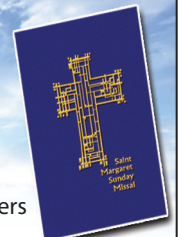
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
