SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

SUNDAY READINGS: Zep. 2:3; 3:12-13, 1 Cor. 1:26-31, Mt. 5:1-12a

Poem by Samuel Taylor Coleridge:

*"Farewell, farewell! but this I tell
To Thee, thou Wedding Guest!
He prayeth well, who loveth well
Both man and bird and beast.
He prayeth best, who loveth best
All things both great and small;
For the dear God who loveth us,
He made and loveth all."*

Poets can be at times theologians. Coleridge offers us an insight regarding the authenticity of our prayer. A person and a community pray best when love is expressed in active concern for others. By contrast, to pray daily and to worship weekly within one's community yet fail to be deeply concerned about the well-being of others raises serious questions about the quality and sincerity of our prayer.

Matthew's Beatitudes today challenges us to give the command to love God and neighbor the steadfast commitment it deserves. Reflect on how your prayer life finds expression in loving deeds; and then ask yourself two questions: "What have I done today to improve the lot of humanity?" "Am I living my life as Christ would want me to?"
