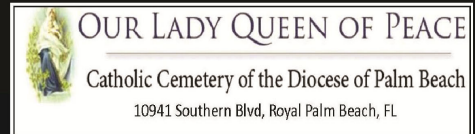
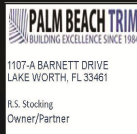

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

SUNDAY READINGS: Sir 35:12-14, 16-18; 2 Tim 4:6-8, 16-18; Lk. 18:9-14

Theme: Jesus uses the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector to teach us to be humble and not judge others.

In this Jubilee Year of Mercy, we are encouraged to be merciful as God is merciful. Jesus teaches us to see God our Father not so much as a judge ready to condemn and punish us, but rather as the God who knows our fragility and forgives us anyway. For God, mercy is the key. It is simply God's nature to forgive, no matter what our sin may be. Once we acknowledge that God is merciful towards us, then we are called to show mercy towards others. None of us is in a position to judge others or to build ourselves up by putting others down. Pope Francis describes the Church, wherever it is to be found, as "an oasis of mercy." Every little grouping where two or three gather in the name of Jesus is to be such "an oasis of mercy." But we will only be able to invite others into this oasis when we have drunk from the fountain of mercy ourselves. Thus, far from criticizing others and setting ourselves apart from others, we are called to develop hearts that are welcoming, communities that reach out especially to those who are weak and poor. We are to be the face of God's mercy in a world that experiences so much injustice and hatred. And so let us ask God for the humility first to know our own need for mercy, and then to help us build "oases of mercy" where all the hurts of our world may find healing and peace. 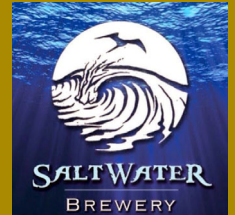

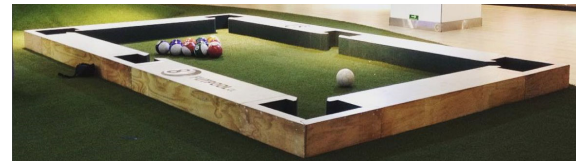

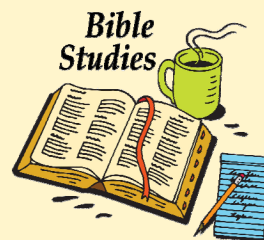
