"We've Been Called"

A group of high school students were assigned to do a service project at a community outreach center. When they arrived for their orientation, they encountered a homeless man asleep on the sidewalk in front of the center, located in an old rundown building. The students snickered and made cruel jokes about the homeless man.

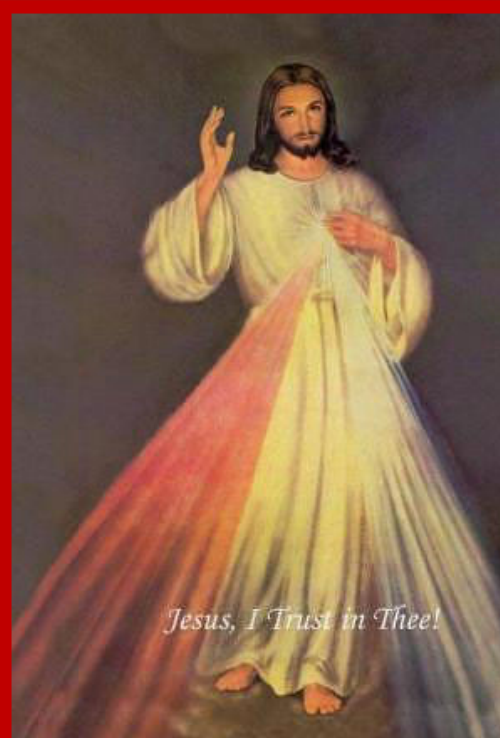
When they entered the center, there was a note at the front desk: "Back in 10 minutes. Have a seat." The students took seats in the waiting area. A few minutes later, the homeless man wandered into the center. The students smirked as he fixed himself a cup of coffee. But their whispers turned to stunned silence when the homeless man removed his shabby overcoat. Despite the worn sneakers he wore, the students recognized immediately that this was not a vagrant.

"Welcome. I'm Tom Gallagher, the director of the center." The students realized that Mr. Gallagher had heard every one of their vicious jokes. They sank into their chairs, never more embarrassed in their lives.

"Let this be your first lesson in community service," Mr. Gallagher said softly, "You can't really reach out to people if you judge them or make fun of them. A person's appearance has little to do with character. We are all human beings who will need the help of one another at some point in our lives."

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges all of us - Pharisee and woman, teacher and student, parent and child - to reach out beyond our disappointment and disapproval of one another's failures and lift up one another when we stumble; to look within our own lives to confront the sins and evil that are part of every life and find there the mercy and compassion that leads to healing and life. We cannot pass sentence on others until we judge our own lives; and we cannot change what is beyond us until we work at repairing what is broken within us. [adapted from "Connections" 07]

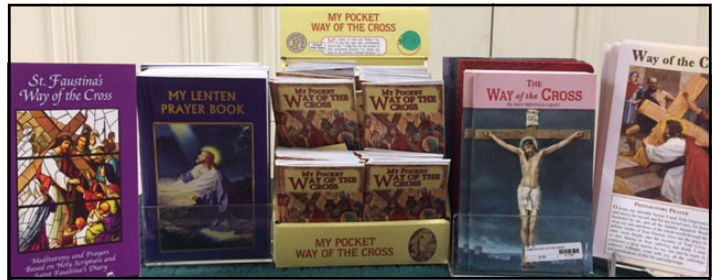

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

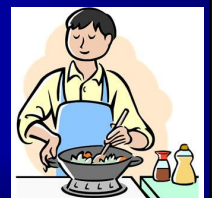

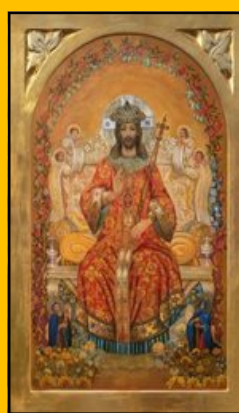
Bible Study

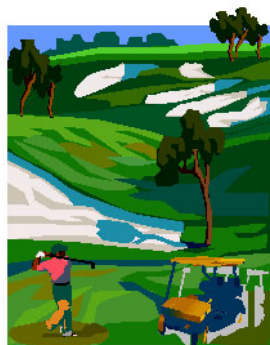

3. Dar de beber al sediento (continuación)

Cristo dijo que estaría con nosotros hasta el final de los tiempos, y uno se podría preguntar: ¿dónde está Él en este año 2016? La respuesta es que el Señor se ha querido quedar presente en los pobres y necesitados, por eso nos dijo también "pobres los tendréis siempre, a mí no" (Jn 12,8). Lo que le hicimos a uno de estos necesitados se lo hicimos a Él. Cuenta la historia de que el día en que la madre de Santa Rosa de Lima reprendió a su hija por atender en la casa a pobres y enfermos, ella le contestó: "Cuando servimos a los pobres y a los enfermos, servimos a Jesús". Esta breve anécdota nos recuerda que en las obras de misericordia estamos sirviendo directamente a Jesús. Dar un vaso de agua al sediento no es solo un acto de amor a esa persona, es un acto de amor directo a Jesús. Para el cristiano servir es reinar, particularmente en los pobres y en los que sufren, pues en ello descubre la imagen de su Creador pobre y sufriente (cf. *Lumen Gentium*, n. 36). Dar de beber al sediento es un servicio que está al alcance de muchos, y que permite reinar desde el amor. Una obra de misericordia que no solo saciará al sediento, sino que también saciará esa sed profunda que todos tenemos de felicidad en nuestro corazón. Porque es dando que se tiene vida, y el Padre que ve en lo secreto nos recompensará.

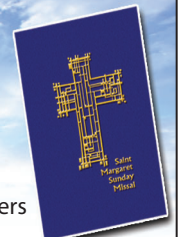
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
