Deacon's Corner.... Deacon Steve SUNDAY READINGS: Numbers 11:25-29; James 5:1-6; Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

At the beginning of today's Gospel, Jesus sets the guidelines and principles of ecumenical and interfaith dialogue. The premise for so many years, even centuries, was that those who were not of the Catholic faith were enemies. How many sins against God's love were committed in the name of religion! When we look at our record of sins against Jews, Protestants, Muslims, etc., the list is staggering. We, who were to be the preachers of the gospel of love, became content to isolate all others because they did not possess "the truth."

We almost never saw the good that others were doing or the truth and beauty that they were teaching and preaching. In reality, almost everything one hears in a church, mosque or synagogue is the message of God's love. Since Vatican II all the popes have called us to embrace one another, to learn from one another, and to pray with one another,

How much more richer our church would become when we are in loving and open dialogue with sisters and brothers of other faiths. We have so much to teach one another. Jesus calls us to tear down the walls that separate and divide us and to learn to live together in peace and mutual service.

As we allow Jesus to melt away the vestiges of prejudice in our hearts, we see the kingdom of God more powerfully in our lives and in our churches. As we begin to see everyone as friend and sister and brother, we will know that Jesus is truly present and with us.

And as true as this is in terms of ecumenical dialogue, how much more truthful it is in the internal life of Catholics themselves. We need to learn from, and talk to, one another.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.
