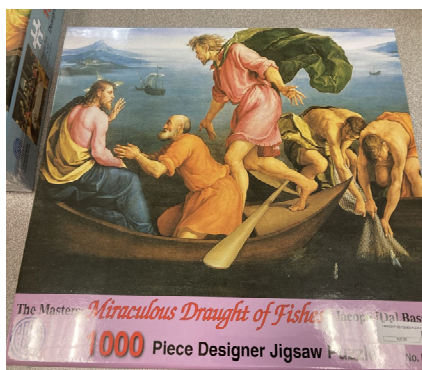


What should I do with my old palms?

Baptisms: Congratulations on the decision to baptize your child in the Catholic Faith! We are here to help you with the process. 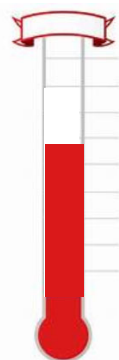

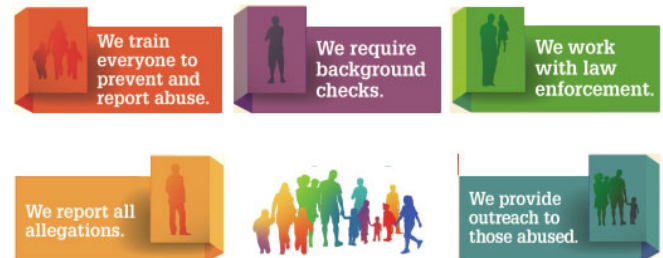

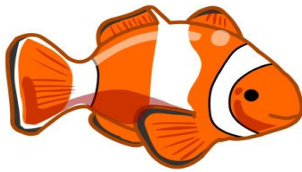

5º Domingo de Cuaresma: no huyas, pide ayuda

Nosotros también temblamos ante el dolor, ante las pruebas, las que tenemos o las que prevemos. Es lógico. Es humano. Si no nos ocurriera eso habríamos dejado de ser seres humanos. No nos tiene que asustar sentir miedo o tener ganas de dar la espalda a los problemas. 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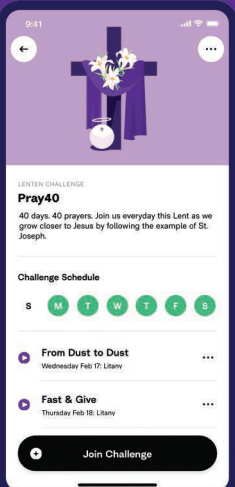
