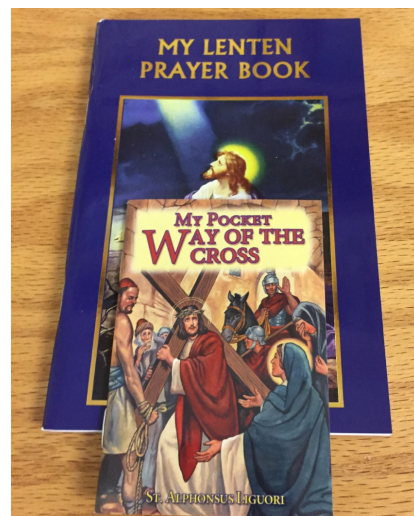
Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

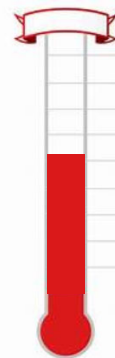

Liturgy Notes

Last Sunday, we celebrated the Second Sunday of Lent, Cycle A, with the Gospel according to Matthew. In all three cycles for the Second Sunday of Lent, we hear of the transfiguration of Jesus before Peter, James, and John. The custom of reading this Gospel near the beginning of Lent comes from an ancient tradition that held that Jesus' transfiguration took place 40 days before His death on the cross.

Have you noticed that there are more than 40 days in the Lenten season? In early centuries, Lent began on the Sixth Sunday before Easter and ended on Holy Thursday evening, thus making for a 40 day season. By the 6th century, Lent began on the Wednesday before and included Good Friday and Holy Saturday in order to account for 40 days, excluding Sundays. In the 20th Century, the liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council restored Good Friday and Holy Saturday to their place in the Triduum, but retained Ash Wednesday as the first day of Lent.

One of the oldest and best-loved Lenten hymns which we used on Ash Wednesday is "The Glory of these Forty Days." The words were written in the sixth century and are attributed to Pope Saint Gregory the Great. The tune was written in 1543 by Joseph Klug, later harmonized by Johann Sebastian Bach.

"The glory of these forty days we celebrate with songs of praise; For Christ by whom all things were made, Himself has fasted and has prayed."

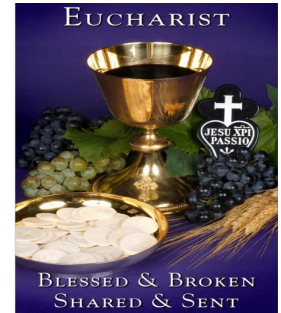
