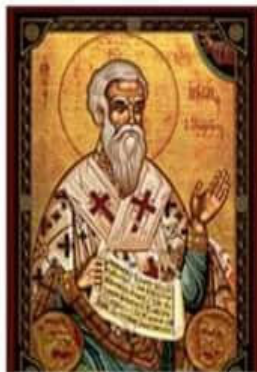

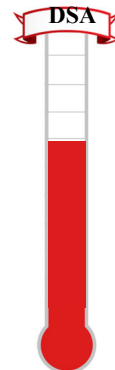

Next weekend, the parishes in our diocese will participate in a second collection for World Mission Sunday, observed on October 23, 2022. World Mission Sunday honors the modern missionaries of the Church who follow the Gospel mandate to go out and preach to all nations. Pope Francis' message for World Mission Sunday this year urges all Christians to proclaim Christ's message of salvation in every aspect of our daily lives. The theme for 2022 is: "You shall be my witnesses" (Acts 1:8). The Pope expressed his desire that we all embrace our vocation as missionary disciples of Christ.

The collection supports more than a thousand local churches in Asia and Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe. When we support this collection, we join together to aid these missions and ministries, and provide help for some of the most vulnerable communities around the world.

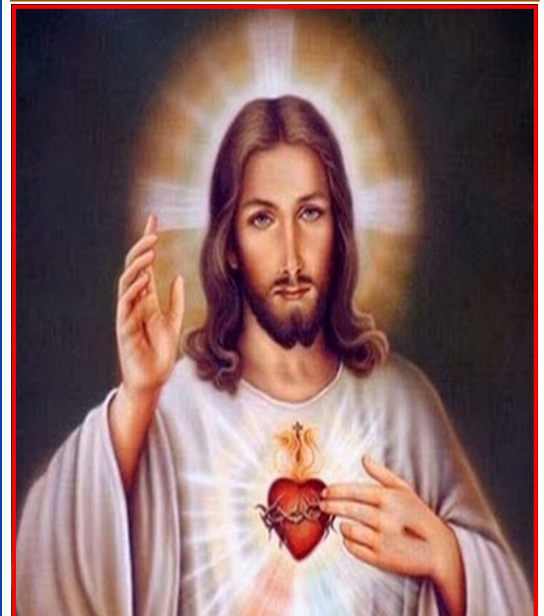
