SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

Deacon's Corner

SUNDAY READINGS:

A few years ago, a N.Y.C. English teacher challenged her high school students to write a letter to their favorite author and invite him or her to visit the school. Five students wrote to Kurt Vonnegut, the author of such classic novels as "Slaughterhouse Five" and "Breakfast of Champions." The author responded that because of failing health he no longer made public appearances, but he offered them this advice: "Practice any art – music, singing, dancing, sculpting, poetry, fiction, essays – no matter how well or badly, not to get money or fame, but to experience becoming, to find out what's inside you, to make your soul grow. Seriously! I mean start right now, do art and do it for the rest of your lives. Draw a funny or a nice picture of your teacher and give it to her. Dance home after school, and sing in the shower. Make a face in your mashed potatoes." Then Vonnegut gave the students an assignment "and I hope your teacher will flunk you if you don't do it: Write a six-line poem about anything, but rhymed... Make it as good as you possibly can. But don't tell anybody what you're doing. Don't show it or recite it to anybody, not even your girlfriend or parents or whatever... then tear it up into teeny-weeny pieces and discard them into widely separated trash receptacles. You will find that you have already been gloriously rewarded for your poem. You have experienced becoming, learned a lot about what's inside, and you have made your soul grow. "God bless you all! Kurt Vonnegut." Jesus suggests a similar "homework assignment" to us in today's Gospel. He challenges us to "make our souls grow" by making time in our lives for the "poetry" of generosity, forgiveness, peace. As we look ahead to Ash Wednesday this week, resolve to do something "poetic" this Lent: write about the many ways you experience God's love in your life; unplug from the world and spend some quiet time walking in a park, at the beach or reconnect with someone you've lost contact with. Take up Vonnegut's challenge: learn what's inside you; and "make your soul grow."
