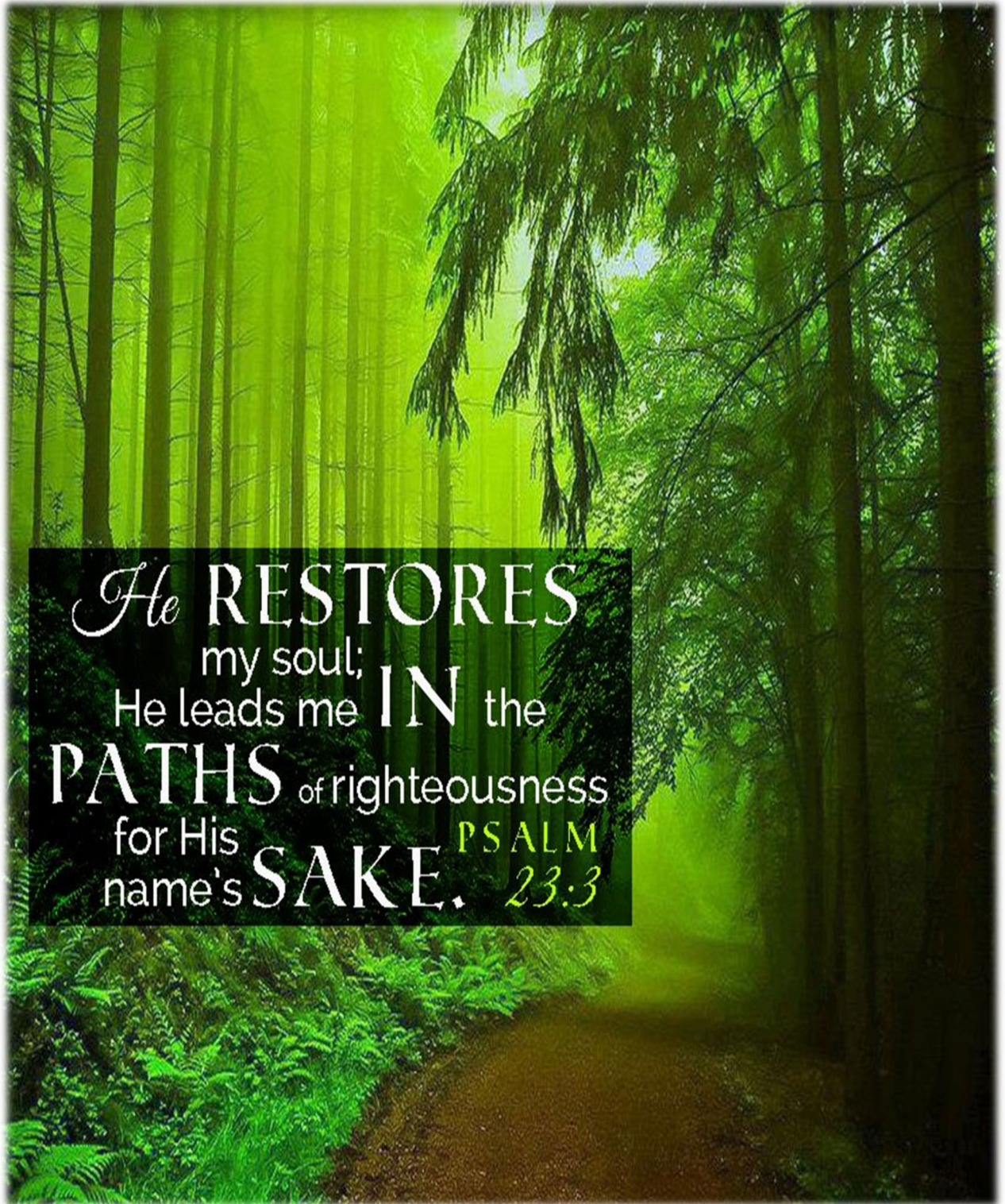

UPDATED INFORMATION WITH REGARDS TO THE REOPENING OF OUR CHURCH

- North and south entry doors will once again be unlocked prior to the start of Mass. Once Mass begins, entrance to the church will only be through the main doors. This is done for security purposes.
- Fully vaccinated individuals may attend Mass without wearing their mask, if they so choose. Those not vaccinated and those who want to wear a mask should sit in the designated area.
- Confessions will take place in the confessionals (no longer in the cry room). Please use the back row of the Adoration Chapel as you await your turn in line.
- The cry room is available for family use once again.
- Weekday services (Rosary, Adoration, and Divine Mercy Chaplet) will NO LONGER be livestreamed. Tuesday and Thursday morning Masses, as well as the Sunday 11:30 Mass WILL CONTINUE to be livestreamed - with a code. To watch the livestream Mass, you will need to call the parish office for this code.
- Our beautiful Adoration Chapel will open, with limited hours, beginning August 2nd. Guidelines for masks are the same as for Mass attendance (with the exception of a designated area). See elsewhere in this bulletin for details about signing up.
- Coffee and Donuts have resumed! Everyone is welcomed to fellowship in the pavilion after the 8:00 and 9:45 Sunday morning Masses.
- PREP and RCIA will resume in-class faith formation beginning in September. See future bulletins for more information and details.
