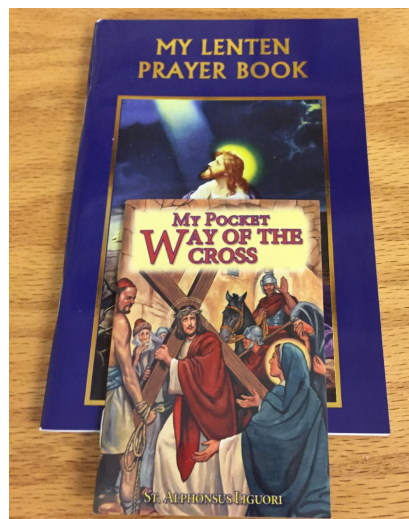
Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

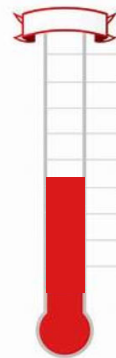

Important Information regarding the Coronavirus

Although there are currently no known outbreaks or local infections in the area of the Diocese of Palm Beach, the diocese continues to closely monitor the developments related to coronavirus (COVID-19).

Please take precautionary measures to prevent the spread of respiratory infection. The CDC suggests such actions as avoid close contact with people who are sick; avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth; stay home when you are sick; cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash; clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes; and wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

Other precautions that you can employ at church include the temporary suspension of the communal Sign of Peace (kissing or shaking of hands), holding hands during the Our Father, and shaking hands or hugging the priest after Mass.

It is important to remember, if you are sick, you are encouraged to stay home. A Diocese of Palm Beach Televised Catholic Mass ministry is available for the community if you are not able to attend Mass. Liturgy Notes

Lent began with Ash Wednesday and continues until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening. The season prepares us for the celebration of Easter through a two-fold theme of repentance and baptism. The penitential character of the season is reflected in the use of violet vestments. The sanctuary and the altar are also dressed in solemn violet, while flower decorations are prohibited. Our Lenten liturgies take on a penitential character, too. We refrain from singing the Gloria, our joyful song of praise, as we did during the season of Advent. We also refrain from singing our Alleluia. This custom is an ancient one. In the early Church, the Alleluia which means "Praise God," was sung only for Easter. Over time, the Alleluia became a regular part of liturgy, but retained its Easter message. For that reason, it was omitted during Lenten liturgies as a penitential sign of the season.

You may have noticed at last weekend's liturgies, that we recited the Apostles' Creed in place of the Nicene Creed. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal, (GIRM) states that during Lent and Easter Time, the Baptismal Symbol of the Roman Church, known as the Apostles' Creed, may be used.

Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,

At the words that follow, up to and including the Virgin Mary, all bow.

who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died and was buried;

he descended into hell;
on the third day he rose again from the dead;
he ascended into heaven,

and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty;
from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

Todos, en alguna ocasión, nos hemos sentido iluminados por Dios. En ocasiones habrá sido por medio de una enfermedad, que nos habrá hecho reflexionar sobre el tipo de vida que estábamos llevando. En otras ocasiones habrá influido un amigo o quizá un sacerdote, los cuales nos habrán ayudado a darnos cuenta de dónde está la verdadera felicidad. Puede ser incluso que Dios se haya hecho presente de modo especial en nuestra vida a través de algún momento difícil o, por el contrario, mediante una sucesiva serie de alegrías.
