


Immunizations for Health

Memorial



St Augustine was born in Thagaste (Algeria) and despite the example of his mother, became a Manichean and fathered an illegitimate child. He was converted at the age of 33 and baptised by St Ambrose of Milan. St Augustine became Bishop of Hippo Regius (now Annaba, Algeria) and wrote and preached energetically in defence of the faith, making him one of the most influential Doctors of the Church.


