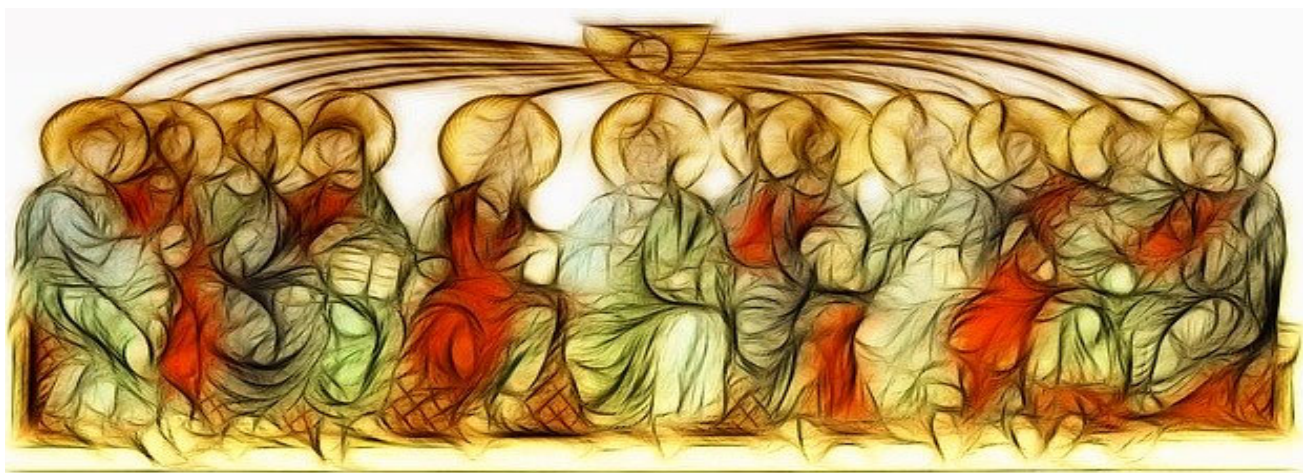

El cultivo de la virtud de la esperanza

Podemos decir que la fiesta de la Anunciación nos invita a tener nuestra mirada fija en el cielo, donde reside Cristo a la derecha del Padre, pero las manos y el esfuerzo en esta tierra que sigue teniendo necesidad de la manifestación de los hijos de Dios. Es una invitación a seguir trabajando por construir la "civilización del amor" y "dar razón de nuestra esperanza a todo aquel que nos la pidiere" (1 Pt 3,15). El cristiano debe ser un hombre de esperanza y de luz en medio de un mundo de tanta tiniebla. 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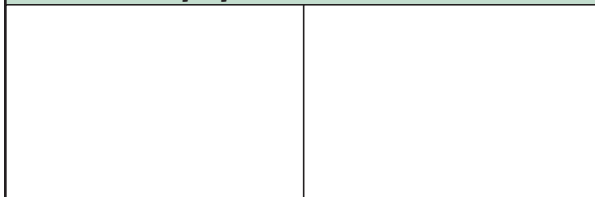
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
