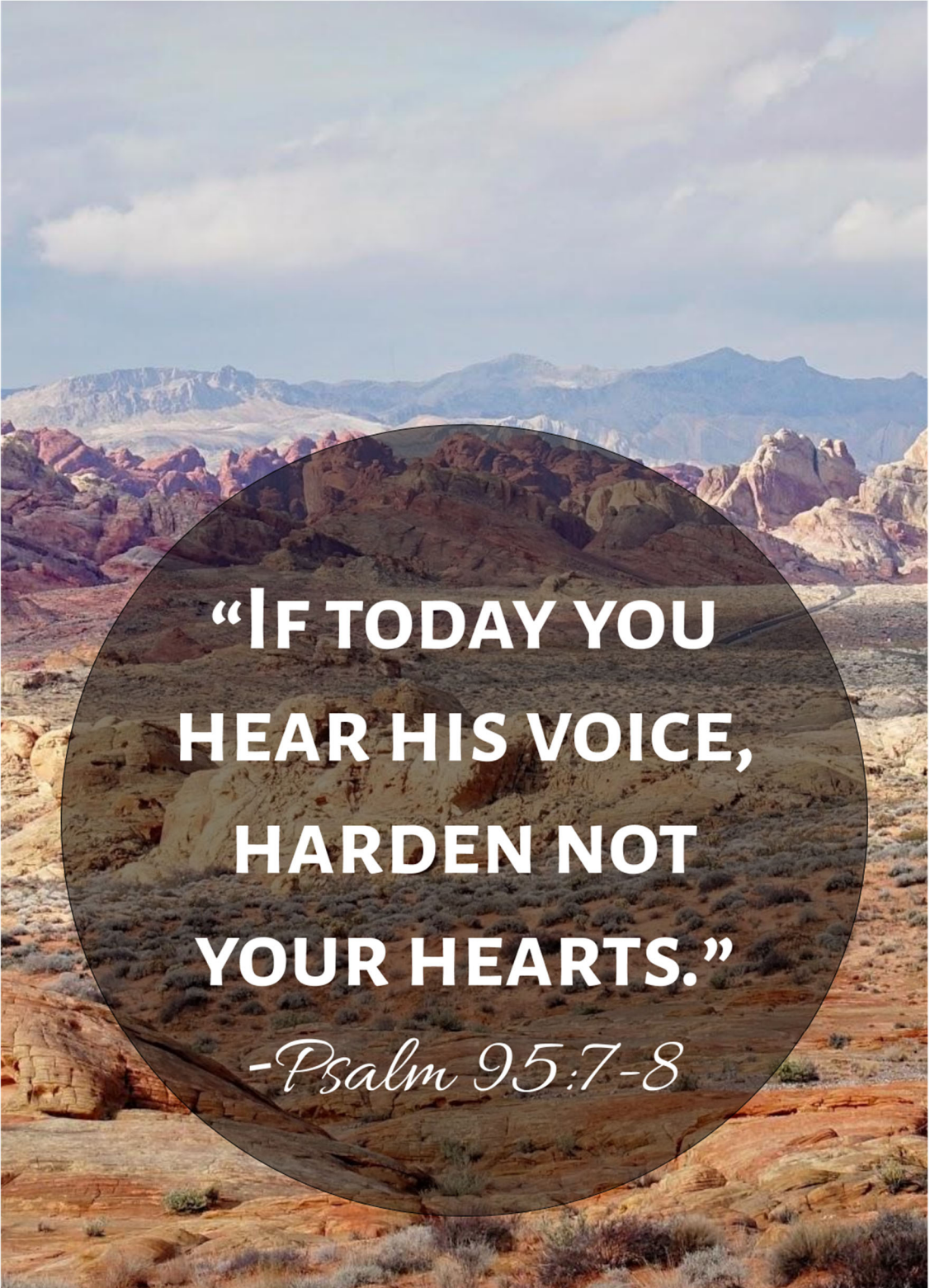

Baptisms: Congratulations on the decision to baptize your child in the Catholic Faith! We are here to help you with the process. Please call or stop by the parish office and we will be happy to get you started. Travel plans for out-of-town guests should not be made until a date for the baptism is confirmed by the parish staff. A meeting with a priest *may* be required. We look forward to hearing from you.

Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: We are blessed to have a group of volunteers in our parish who are happy to bring Holy Communion to the sick, the hospitalized and the homebound. Please call the parish office to make arrangements if you or your loved one would like a priest to visit with the Sacrament of Anointing.

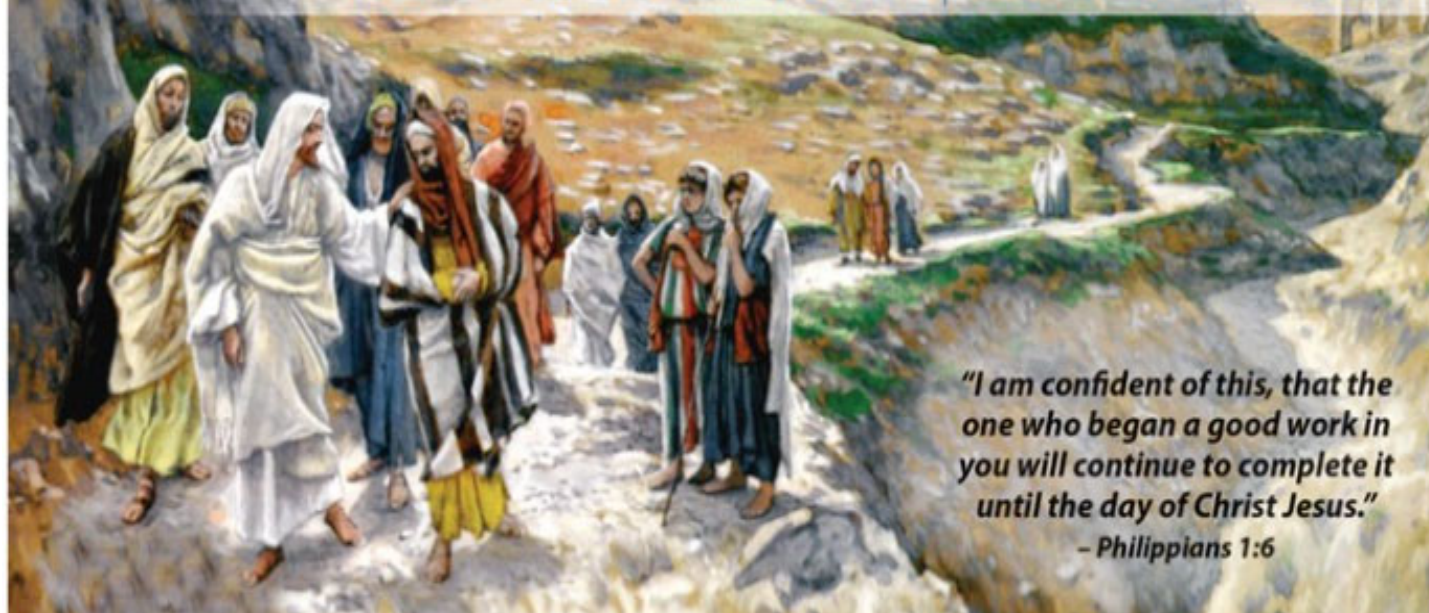

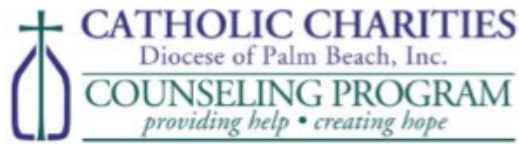

Dale a Dios tu pobreza

El caso del hombre poseído al que Jesús liberó del espíritu inmundo nos sitúa delante de nuestras propias inmundicias. Muchos de los ataques que sufre la Iglesia tienen como origen, la rabia que experimentan contra esta institución los que están inmersos en el mal, en la basura, en el pecado. No pueden tolerar la existencia de una realidad que defiende el bien, la castidad, la pobreza y aprovechan defectos reales de algunos de sus miembros para intentar destruirla. En el fondo de esos ataques está este sentimiento: "Ellos, los que predicán que hay que hacer el bien, tienen tanto pecado como nosotros". Quizá en parte tengan razón, pero la predicación de la conversión y de la existencia objetiva del bien no debe dejar de hacerse, precisamente para evitar el triunfo definitivo del mal. Pero en otros casos, la conciencia de los propios pecados aleja de Dios. ¿Cómo va Dios a amarme?, piensan algunos. Yo no tengo solución, dicen otros. En estos casos se trata de darle a Dios precisamente la pobreza personal y de dársela junto con la parte buena que sin duda también se tiene. La una, mediante el arrepentimiento, la confesión y la lucha por mejorar. La otra, mediante el ejercicio y desarrollo de aquellas virtudes y cualidades con las que Dios ha dotado a todos, aunque sean diferentes en cada uno.
