Deacon's Corner.... SUNDAY READINGS: Jeremiah 31:7-9; Hebrews 5:1-6; Mark 10:46-52

Scripture reminds us that God is always faithful. He is true to his promises, steadfast in his mercy, his compassion and loving. Even when countless generations ignored the prophets and turned away from the commandments, God remained faithful to his covenants. He loves us so much that he sent his only Son to demonstrate that love.

Such a level of faithfulness inspires faith. We are convinced of God's fidelity to his promises as made through Jesus, manifested in His life, death and resurrection. Faith grows when we have an unwavering trust in another person. Our faith in God requires humility and gratitude. And when our faith is strong, it is easily expressed and shared.

Bartimaeus, the blind beggar, appears to have had such faith. He persistently called out to the person he could not see, but knew only by reputation - "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me." Finally, he approaches Jesus with a fervent request: "Master, I want to see." Bartimaeus seemed to have every confidence. He somehow knew that Jesus could accomplish what seemed, to others, to be impossible.

Jesus responds to the beggar's deep faith: "Go your way, your faith has saved you." Immediately, the blind man can see and he follows Jesus.

We, too, seek Jesus' help. We cannot see him, but we call out, confident that he will answer. We call him by name, the name the angel gave to Mary: Jesus, meaning "YHWH saves." Because of Jesus' faithfulness and love for us, we approach and we ask for his help, we plead for his mercy, and petition his miracles.

Jesus does not tire of our prayers. The Holy Spirit inspires us to speak them. Our faith reminds us of his faithfulness and the salvation he has given us.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.
