





Dear Parishioners,

This past fiscal year, July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021 has been very challenging. Fortunately, because of a special interest bonus, the giftshop outperforming budget, the generosity of our parishioners with donations, and the PPP loans, we were able to do better than expected. Even though the PPP loans show as a liability, we have just received forgiveness on the first loan, and we expect forgiveness on the second loan as well. These loans helped with paying payroll. Although we showed a loss of **\$75,962**, we did better than budget which was forecasted at a **\$220,689** deficit. Fortunately, donations were very strong and continue to fund the necessary projects on our campus. In addition, our Festival Raffle brought in \$36,761 net income.

Expenses were up from the previous year by \$21,745, due to some repairs and the leak which caused a hole in the church ceiling, streaming equipment, and installation of security cameras (the money was raised separately for streaming and security). We were short on the DSA by \$47,000. Fortunately the Diocese forgave half, so we paid \$23,500. We continue to pay interest only on our mortgage through September, 2021. This, along with the PPP loans, have allowed us to put money into our savings.

The outlook and budget for 2021-22 is cautiously optimistic; in fact, we have budgeted a positive change in net assets for this fiscal year. Part of that is because of the reduction in staff. We have reduced staff by 1 ½ people.

We budgeted our offertory conservatively, as we expect a gradual return to previous performance. Obviously, the effect of the pandemic and the return to normalcy will directly effect how soon we are back to normal.

Unfortunately, we have cancelled the Pumpkin Patch again for 2021 and various other fundraisers. Our plan at this time is to move forward with the Christmas Festival and Village. There is so much work that goes in to making this a success. Our expectation is that the event is outside so, we expect the attendance will be good.


We are working diligently on controlling expenses. We are still short with the DSA over \$30,000 this year. We do not expect the Diocese to forgive any shortfalls. The loss of several fundraisers (We do plan on the Christmas Festival in December. This may be a liability if the pandemic takes a turn and affects us holding the festival.) puts a strain on our financial stability. We understand that times are difficult, and we will get past these difficult times. We will continue to manage our finances tightly and we will keep you informed through the bulletin on a weekly basis by comparing offertory to budget.


Alfred was born in Rhode Island but considers Florida his home. His ministries have taken him to Florida, North Carolina and now back to Florida again.




