SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

Let Your Light Shine Before Others

In today's readings we hear a theme of light. Isaiah tells us that if we feed the hungry, clothe the poor, shelter the homeless, care for the marginalized in society, and fight against lies and oppression, that the light will arise for us, even in our darkness, even when things aren't going the way we would like them. Our Psalm this week expands on this idea, saying that those of us who are "just" will be a light in the darkness of our world. And finally, in our Gospel from Matthew, we are told that WE are the "light of the world!" We are to live our lives so that our light "shines before others, that they may see our good deeds." But unlike the hypocrites who wish to receive respect and admiration, and so perform "good" things for others to see, we are called to do good so that our Heavenly Father is glorified.

A critical difference between doing good for our own ego, and doing good for God's glory is whether the light of Christ is shining through us. What ultimately makes anything we do "good" is the presence of Christ in us and the recognition of Him in others. So we must ask ourselves, and our scripture challenges us: Do others see the light of Christ, the presence of Jesus in us? Do others even know we are followers of Jesus, or are we embarrassed by our faith? Do we shy away from publicly acknowledging our Catholic beliefs, or do we live our lives according to them? Do we stand up for the oppressed and outcasts of society, assist the homeless, helpless, and less fortunate in our community; perhaps a member of our family, someone at school or work, even a friend or acquaintance? If someone asked those who know us, would they say that they see Christ in us? If we don't see Him in others, others will not see Him in us. Let's take time this week to truly reflect on our commitment to Jesus, and to ask God to help us grow in faith, so that we are able to freely act in love and charity toward each other and all those we encounter. Let us ask God to revitalize our spirits and enliven our faith, so that we truly are the Light of the World, for the greater glory of our Heavenly Father.
