SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

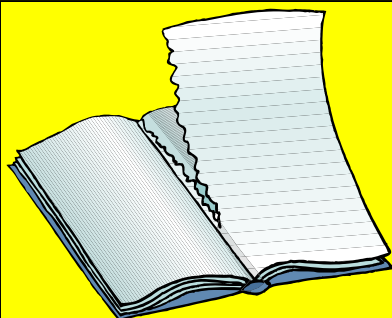
Do you know anyone interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, and possibly becoming a Catholic?

Initiation into the Church takes place at the Easter Vigil.

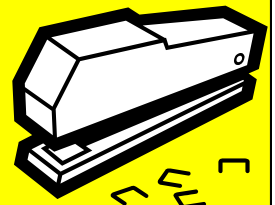

Fr. Brian Campbell originally hails from the state of Illinois where he grew up as a child until his family moved to the Naples area in the late 1980's. Growing up in Southwest Florida, Fr. Campbell enjoys boating, swimming, running and various outdoor activities, as well as travel. After graduating High School in Naples, Father attended Franciscan University of Steubenville where he received a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy and Theology in 2002. During that time he was discerning a vocation to the ministerial priesthood and in 2003 became a Seminarian for the Diocese of Palm Beach, FL. As a seminarian he completed some important assignments for priestly training. These assignments include a year of Pre-Theology at St. John Vianney Seminary in Miami followed by four years of theology and formation at Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans, where he graduated with an M.Div. in 2009. Other pastoral training experiences included a summer unit of Clinical Pastoral Education at the Methodist Hospital in Houston, TX., four parish assignments and a

Diaconate internship at Sacred Heart Church in Lake Worth, FL. Fr. Campbell was ordained by Bishop Barbarito to the Priesthood on May 2, 2009 and has served at St. Patrick Church in Palm Beach Gardens (2009-20012), St. Vincent Ferrer Church in Delray Beach (2012-2015) and is now happily serving as Parochial Vicar at our parish of Our Lady Queen of the Apostles. Father Campbell looks forward to working together with Fr. Laurent and our Pastor, Fr. Andy, to serve the needs of the people of God in the greater Royal Palm Beach community. Fr. Campbell loves to teach about the Scriptures and is fully committed to Catholic Christianity as the fullest expression of historic Christian discipleship. 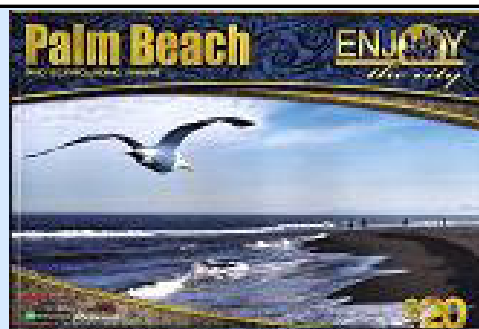
