SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

SUNDAY READINGS: Isa 49:3, 5-6. 1 Cor. 1:1-3. Jn. 1:29-34

Sr. Joan Chittister loves writing stories that pave a pathway to meaning and purpose. The following one: "Being Imperfect" is a good one for the beginning of Ordinary Time.

The Talmud tells of an old man in the village who kept giving money to ne'er-do-wells. The villagers were aghast at such wantonness. "Why give these people money when you know they'll only waste it?" they wanted to know. And the old man answered, "Shall I be pickier with them than God has been with me?"

"I ran through the pane glass front of a candy store when I was ten years old. Besides the fact that I was not to be in that particular store at that particular time, it was an added expense that my parents could not really afford at the time. I sat on the living room floor all day long waiting for my father to come home and punish me. But all he said was, "Are you hurt? No? Then good, what did you learn from it?" I didn't merit that love."

"And I have an idea that someplace along the line, even you have managed to escape the just dessert of your actions. In fact, we'd all be somewhere else right now if God were a God of arithmetic. None of us have perfect scores. All of us have been saved from ourselves and through no merit of our own."

"And that's the problem: If we have to merit heaven, we're never going to get it. Because we can't. We aren't made to be perfect; we're made to be us. We're made to grow slowly. We're made to begin again and again and again. We're made to demonstrate God's justice and exercise God's mercy, both of which are clearly different from our own."

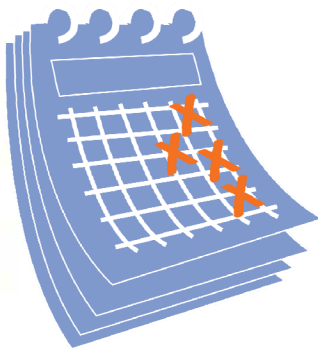
