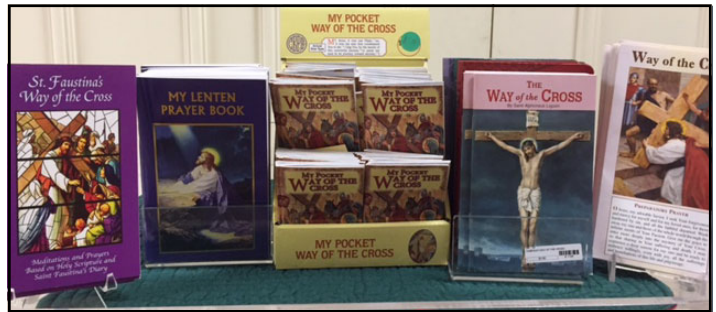

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

PROPER ETIQUETTE & DRESS FOR CONFIRMATION

(please share this with Sponsors and all attending)

Boys: dress pants, white or light color dress shirt, tie, dress shoes & socks (no sandals, flip-flops, sneakers).

Girls: modest white or light colored dress, or skirt (no low-cut, mini or floor length) or dress slacks w. modest top, dress shoes or dress sandals (no flip-flops or sneakers).

Sponsors:

Men: dress shirt, tie, dress pants, (sport coat or suit optional but appropriate), dress shoes & socks (no sandals, flip-flops, sneakers).

Women: Modest dress or skirt (no mini lengths) or dress slacks and modest top, dress shoes or dress sandals (no flip-flops, sneakers).

Etiquette: Maintain sanctity of the occasion. Respect others in prayer. Refrain from talking before/during the Mass. *No cell phone usage; no texting during the Mass.*

No flash photos; photos from seats only. Remain seated, no standing along walls, or blocking doorways. No food, no gum chewing, no drinks permitted (incl. water bottles). Professional photographer takes group photo first, then take family portraits w. Bishop. (will line up for this)

Remember, you are **CHOSEN!** You are loved, and this parish is your home! May God continue to bless you. Mrs. Rosemary

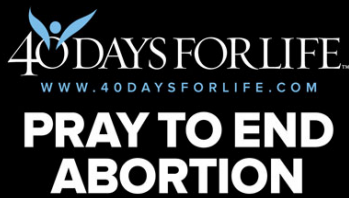

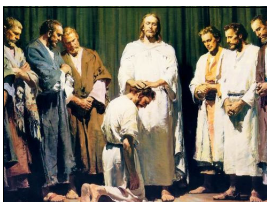
Stations of the Cross

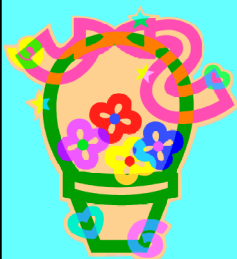

"Venid, benditos de mi Padre, recibid la herencia del Reino preparado para vosotros desde la creación del mundo. Porque tuve hambre, y me disteis de comer (...) Entonces los justos le responderán: «Señor, ¿cuándo te vimos hambriento, y te dimos de comer (...)?» Y el Rey les dirá: En verdad os digo que cuanto hicisteis a unos de estos hermanos míos más pequeños, a mí me lo hicisteis" (Mt 25,34-40).

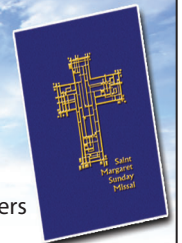
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
