SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

"I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing...Do you think that I have come to establish peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." (Luke 12: 49-53).

You have just said "No" to your teenager. Homework trumps going to the mall with her friends; going to his buddy's unchaperoned party on Saturday night is not going to happen; the commitment your son and daughter made to babysit for the family down the street will be honored despite the unexpected opportunity to go to the beach. Your "No" has been met with a slam of the bedroom door, an angry stalking off, and silence. You are confronted with a petition to do something about "them," to stop "them," to get rid of "them." But you know "them" and they are good and decent people. But their race, their ethnicity, their religion, their politics makes "them" a target for the anger and fears of some folks in the community. So despite the snide remarks and intimidating stares of the petitioners, you refuse to sign and walk away, knowing full well that you have not heard the last of this.

Yes, you feel like the worst parent, the worst neighbor. To say "No" to what is wrong, to what is unjust, to what is divisive often erects walls between us and others, but such a "No" is often the price of discipleship. Jesus' striking words in today's Gospel are painfully clear: Jesus comes to proclaim a demanding Gospel of compassion, forgiveness and justice that is often at odds with the values and conventions of our world. The Gospel is neither easy or comfortable; it is challenging and demanding and, in its call to the work of reconciliation and justice, can be divisive and confrontational, sometimes putting us and those we love on opposing sides. Discipleship is not without cost; balancing the Gospel imperatives with the day-to-day practical realities of our lives is very difficult.

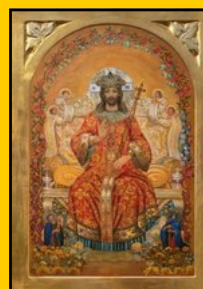

Esta es la célebre oración atribuida a San Francisco de Asís, aunque en realidad fue escrita en 1912: Oh Señor, hazme un instrumento de tu paz... Oh maestro, haced que yo no busque tanto el ser consolado, sino consolar; ser comprendido, sino comprender; ser amado, sino amar. Porque es dando que se recibe; perdonando que se es perdonado y muriendo que se resucita a la vida eterna.

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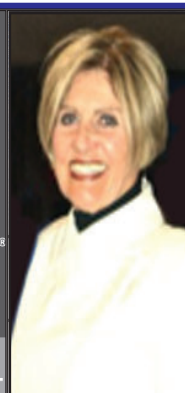
