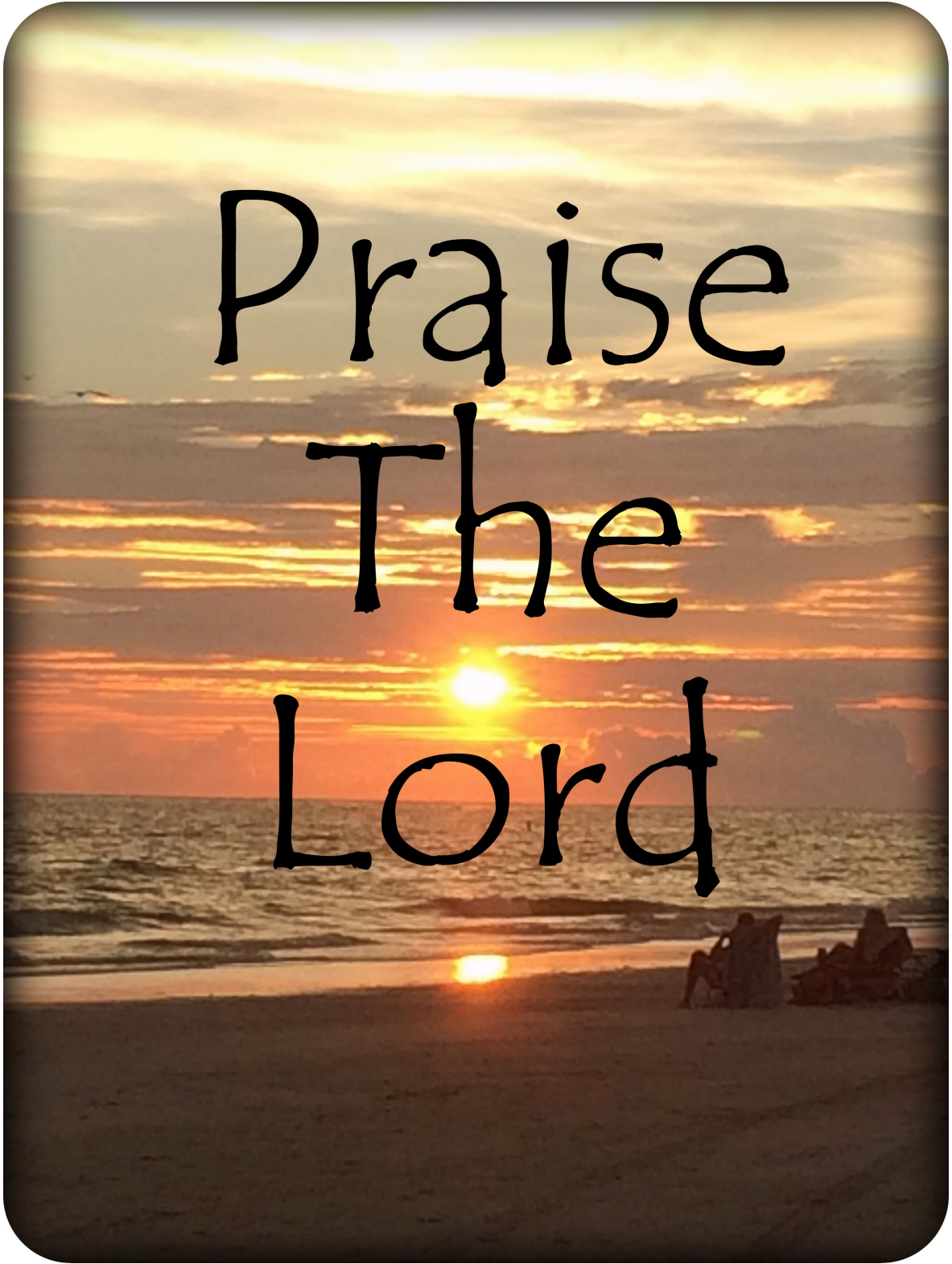

Baptisms: Congratulations on the decision to baptize your child in the Catholic Faith! We are here to help you with the process. Please call or stop by the parish office and we will be happy to get you started. Travel plans for out-of-town guests should not be made until a date for the baptism is confirmed by the parish staff. A meeting with a priest *may* be required. We look forward to hearing from you.

Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: We are blessed to have a group of volunteers in our parish who are happy to bring Holy Communion to the sick, the hospitalized and the homebound. Please call the parish office to make arrangements if you or your loved one would like a priest to visit with the Sacrament of Anointing.

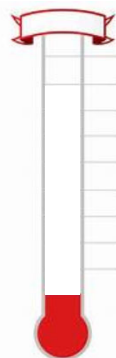

- ⇒ Canned chicken

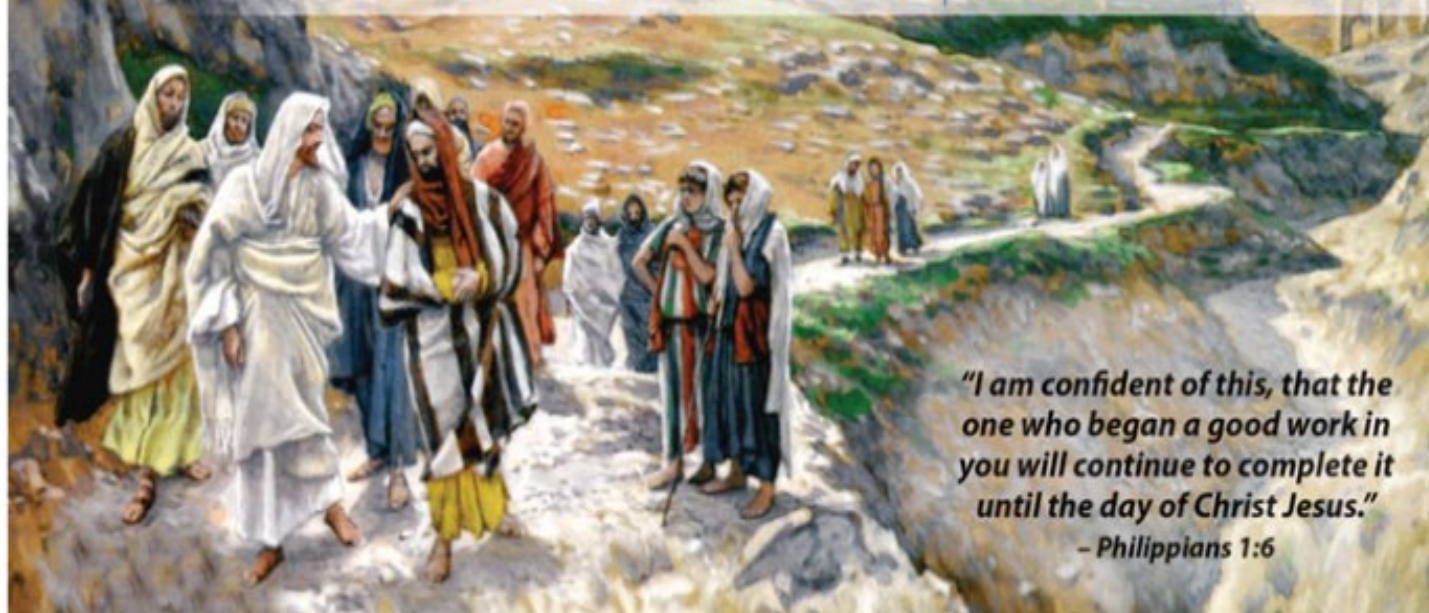

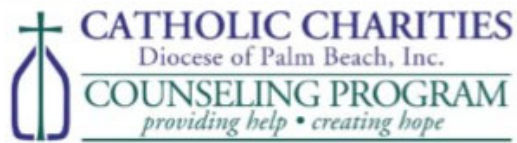

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No tengáis miedo

Jesús nos demuestra, con su comportamiento, que Él no era un hombre que buscaba, por encima de todo, ser bien visto, ni que ansiaba que todos hablaran bien de él. Ante la popularidad responde: “Vámonos a otra parte”. Nosotros, en cambio, decimos eso ante las críticas. Muy pocas veces huimos de los elogios, mientras que nos acobardamos ante los problemas y tendemos a pensar que lo mejor es no tener ninguno, aunque para eso debamos dejar de hacer aquello que Cristo quiere que hagamos. Se trata, pues, de no tener miedo. Se trata de hacer las cosas en conciencia y en fidelidad a la Iglesia. Naturalmente, también en caridad, pero sin que el riesgo de no ser comprendidos, de no ser aplaudidos, nos atenace y nos silencie. Al único que debemos temer es al juicio de Dios y no al juicio de los hombres. Digamos, pues, la verdad siempre con caridad. Démosle al prójimo la caridad de la verdad, a la par que le damos la verdad con caridad. Y si llega el caso de que nos tengamos que ir a otra parte, porque no podemos seguir anunciando la verdad o porque allí no hace ya falta que lo hagamos, no nos hagamos ningún problema por ello. Cristo ya pasó por ese trance, lo mismo que pasó por el de la cruz y el de la resurrección.

3)-Padre de la obediencia:

El Papa señala que “así como Dios hizo con María cuando le manifestó su plan de salvación, también a José le reveló sus designios y lo hizo a través de sueños que, en la Biblia, como en todos los pueblos antiguos, eran considerados uno de los medios por los que Dios manifestaba su voluntad”. “José estaba muy angustiado por el embarazo incomprensible de María”, recuerda el Obispo de Roma, pero “con la obediencia superó su drama y salvó a María”. Tras huir a Egipto para salvar a la Sagrada Familia de la maldad de Herodes, “José esperó con confianza y paciencia el aviso prometido por el ángel para regresar a su país”. “Y cuando en un tercer sueño el mensajero divino, después de haberle informado que los que intentaban matar al niño habían muerto, le ordenó que se levantara, que tomase consigo al niño y a su madre y que volviera a la tierra de Israel, él una vez más obedeció sin vacilar”. De esa manera, “en la vida oculta de Nazaret, bajo la guía de José, Jesús aprendió a hacer la voluntad del Padre”.

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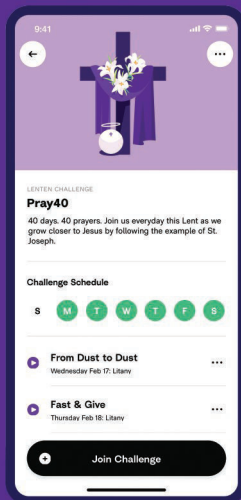
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
