Due to an oversight, Dc. Steve's letter was not posted in last week's bulletin. The readings above relate to his letter below.

"The Lord's heart went out to her and he said, 'Don't weep.'" I learned as a child that the phrase "God's will be done" from the Lord's Prayer means "accept the suffering that God has in store for you, it's for your own good." I'm learning as an adult that God doesn't want anyone to suffer.

Jesus came not to proclaim his Father's cruelty but his compassion and mercy. He became human to demonstrate there is no way out of suffering but a way over it. "In this life you shall see tribulation," he told us, "but be of good cheer for I have overcome the world." (Jn 16:33). Jesus said this so we could understand that if he could transcend suffering, so could we, and if he could work miracles in other peoples lives, he could work them in ours.

The way over trouble is to know that our Father wants only our good, not pain but joy, not illness but wholeness, not anguish but peace. Then, sooner or later, one way or another, we will be in for the surprise of a lifetime.

Whenever we pray "Thy will be done," we are surrendering to the truth that God is not a murderer but a giver of life, not a punisher but a river of mercy.

(Hosea 6:6). "God is Love" (1Jn:4), and love never wants to hurt us. Love can give only what love is. "God's will for us is good, pleasing and perfect." (Ro 12:2).

So when we are agonizing over what should be or should not be, it is helpful to be like the widow and put our fears and weeping in Jesus' hands.

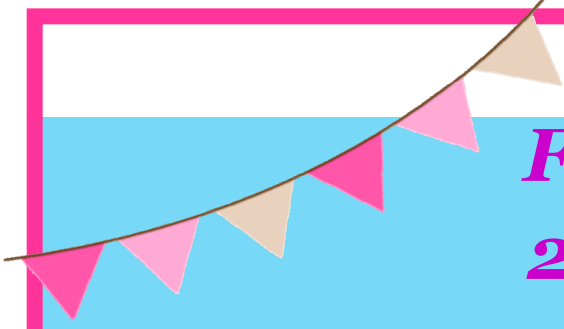


SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

Welcome



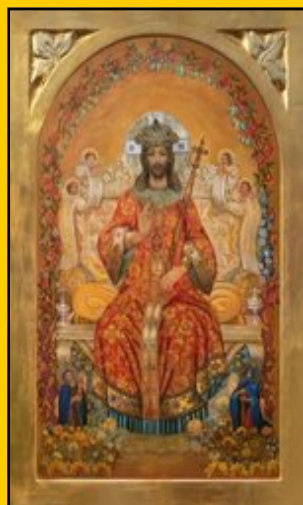

Podemos instruir de múltiples maneras. ¡Incluso sin palabras! Con un buen ejemplo, haciendo en familia otra obra de misericordia corporal y hasta con una sonrisa sincera, enseñando a otro una virtud como la alegría.
