Liturgy Corner

*We have seen His star in the east, and have come with gifts
to adore the Lord.*

Epiphany, a word of Greek origin, means: showing forth, 'manifestation'. Today, our liturgy celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the magi, wise men from the East. It is the manifestation of Christ, the Son of God and Savior of the world.

Originally, the baptism of Jesus and his first miracle at the wedding in Cana were also celebrated on the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. The ancient origins of the feast survive in an antiphon for the Liturgy of the Hours: "Three mysteries mark this holy day: today, the star leads the Magi to the infant Christ; today, water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; today, Christ wills to be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us salvation." We now celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on the Sunday following Epiphany, which marks the end of the Christmas season.



The gifts the magi bring to the Christ child help us to understand who he is: Gold for a king, frankincense for divinity, and myrrh for his suffering and death. In the Prayer over the Gifts, we recognize another manifestation of Christ—the Eucharist: "Lord, accept the offerings of your Church, not gold, frankincense and myrrh, but the sacrifice and food they symbolize: Jesus Christ, who is Lord forever and ever."

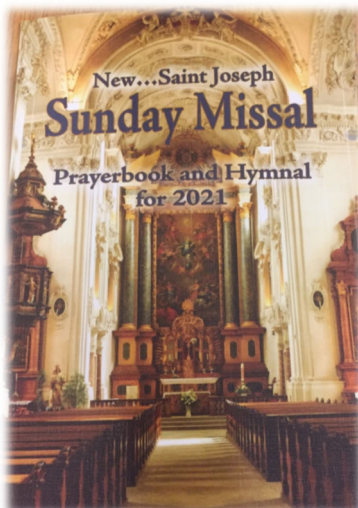


Gift Shop

Sacramental Information

Baptisms: Congratulations on the decision to baptize your child in the Catholic Faith! We are here to help you with the process. Please call or stop by the parish office and we will be happy to get you started. Travel plans for out-of-town guests should not be made until a date for the baptism is confirmed by the parish staff. A meeting with a priest *may* be required. We look forward to hearing from you.

Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: We are blessed to have a group of volunteers in our parish who are happy to bring Holy Communion to the sick, the hospitalized and the homebound. Please call the parish office to make arrangements if you or your loved one would like a priest to visit with the Sacrament of Anointing.

On January 3 we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany (or Feast of the Three Kings). An ancient tradition has parishioners bringing home packets of blessed chalk, using the chalk to inscribe the initials of the legendary Three Kings over the doorway, and invoking their protection of the home.

If you wish, a little donation made in their honor can be left in the basket containing the packets, as you take **one packet per family**. The inscription over the doorway includes the new year, divided by the initials of the three kings.

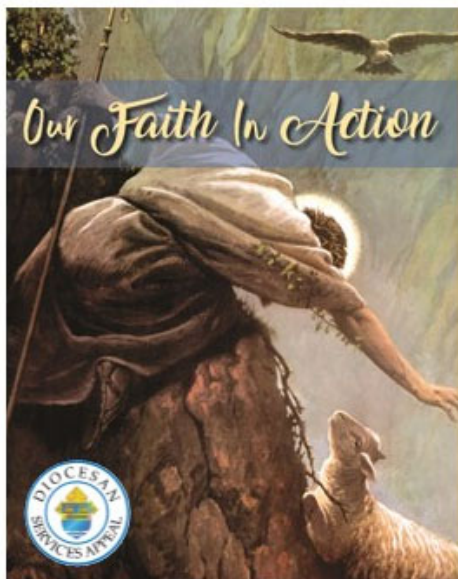
Due to your generosity, we were able to provide Christmas meals to more than 100 families, as well as toys for the children during this holiday season.

La Epifanía del Señor

¿Qué sucede si guiáramos nuestras vidas como si la estrella se detuviera sobre nosotros? La respuesta a esta pregunta es más sorprendente cuando consideramos el Evangelio en su totalidad: su significado y lo que ocurre es que el único camino a la luz y la vida es de morirnos en sí mismos para vencer la oscuridad. La vida tiene sus penas y sufrimientos. También tiene sus alegrías y celebraciones: el misterio de la salvación ha sido revelado en Jesús. Y en nosotros. Los Reyes andaban en búsqueda. Viajaban por la noche, siguiendo la estrella, moviéndose como peregrinos a duras penas por los desiertos. Eso es muy frecuente el modo humano. La mayoría de nosotros caminamos en la oscuridad la mayor parte de nuestras vidas. Esto es lo que los Reyes nos proclaman claramente. ¿Cómo ha sido visible la estrella del Señor para ti en tiempos de tu oscuridad?

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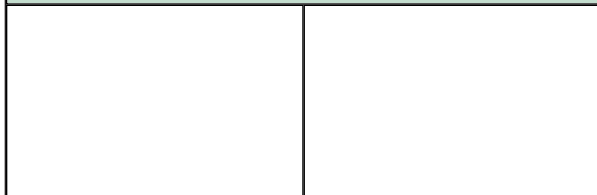
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
