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MINISTERIO HISPANO

El cultivo de la virtud de la esperanza

Podemos decir que la fiesta de la Anunciación nos invita a tener nuestra mirada fija en el cielo, donde reside Cristo a la derecha del Padre, pero las manos y el esfuerzo en esta tierra que sigue teniendo necesidad de la manifestación de los hijos de Dios. Es una invitación a seguir trabajando por construir la “civilización del amor” y “dar razón de nuestra esperanza a todo aquel que nos la pidiere”(1 Pt 3,15). El cristiano debe ser un hombre de esperanza y de luz en medio de un mundo de tanta tiniebla. “La evangelización comprende además la predicación de la esperanza en las promesas hechas por Dios mediante la nueva alianza en Jesucristo; la predicación del amor de Dios para con nosotros y de nuestro amor hacia Dios, la predicación del amor fraterno para con todos los hombres —capacidad de donación y de perdón, de renuncia, de ayuda al hermano— que por descender del amor de Dios, es el núcleo del Evangelio; la predicación del misterio del mal y de la búsqueda activa del bien” No es fácil superar la fuerte tendencia al individualismo en la vivencia de la fe de muchos cristianos. Debemos, por ello, predicar con oportunidad o sin ella, sobre la necesidad de ser apóstoles allí donde la providencia nos ha colocado.

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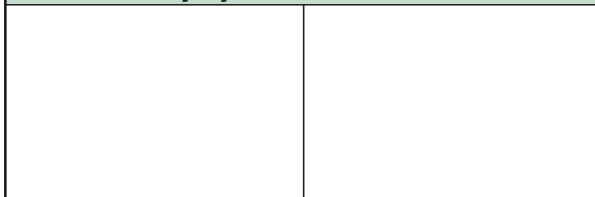
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
