



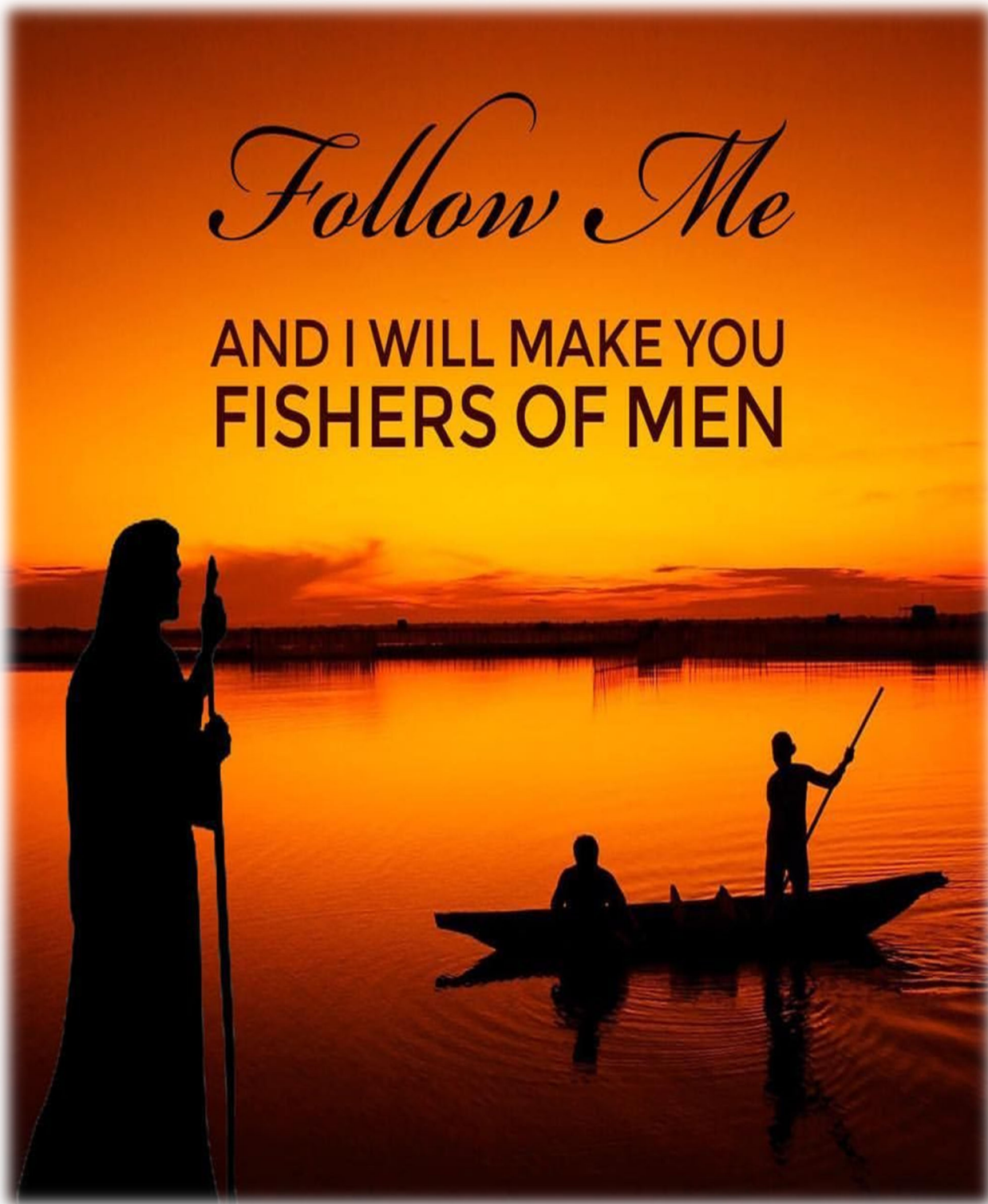

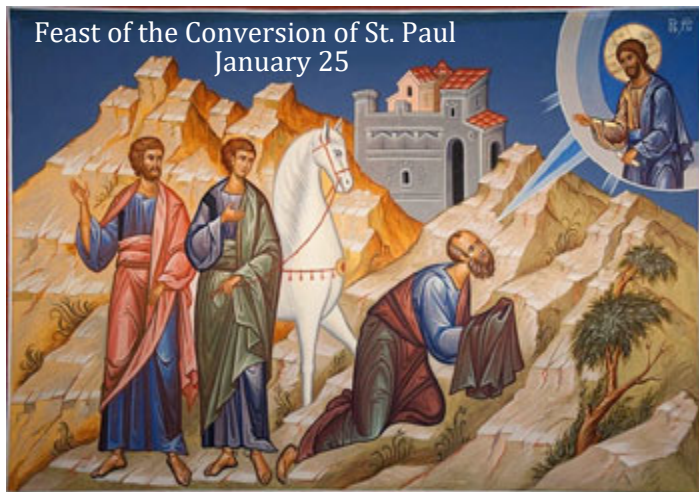

Diocesan Services Appeal

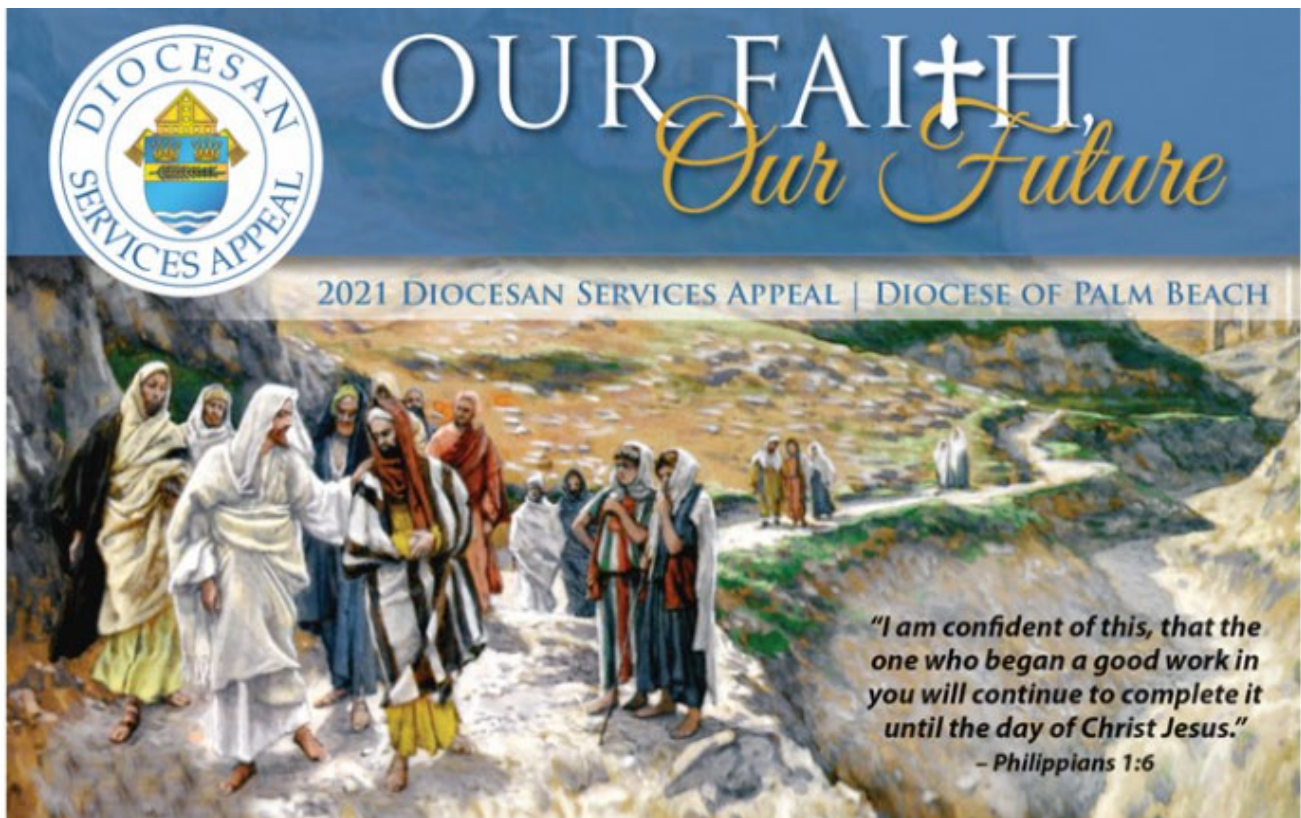

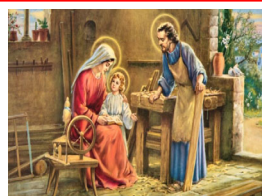

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Elegir la mejor parte

El relato de la vocación de los apóstoles es una invitación a valorar la vocación sacerdotal y la vida religiosa. Para muchos se trata de una opción imposible debido al voto de castidad, ignoran la verdadera fuerza del amor. El fondo de la vocación consagrada y sacerdotal es precisamente el amor: se ama tanto a alguien que se está dispuesto a renunciar a algo legítimo y bueno, como tener una familia, para dedicar-se por entero al Señor y a las cosas de Dios, a la evangelización. ¿Hay mayor prueba de amor que esa?. La vocación nace del amor y el celibato es una llamada a la plenitud del amor, aunque en realidad esto solo lo pueden entender los que están o han estado enamorados. Pero detrás de este texto está también una lección para todos, casados incluidos. Hay otra vocación a seguir a Jesús en el propio estado y a seguirlo con radicalidad, seriedad, plenitud. La vocación a la santidad es común para todos y si no existen las dificultades del celibato o de la obediencia existen las de la convivencia, la educación de los hijos o el testimonio de la propia fe con una vida coherente y honrada en medio de un mundo cada vez más alejado de Dios. Dios nos llama a seguirle, y espera que respondamos como los apóstoles: inmediatamente. Seguir al Señor es lo mejor que nos puede pasar.



Carta apostólica: Patris Corde

1- Padre amado Por su papel en la historia de la salvación, san José es un padre que siempre ha sido amado por el pueblo cristiano, como lo demuestra el hecho de que se le han dedicado numerosas iglesias en todo el mundo; que muchos institutos religiosos, hermandades y grupos eclesiales se inspiran en su espiritualidad y llevan su nombre; y que desde hace siglos se celebran en su honor diversas representaciones sagradas. Muchos santos y santas le tuvieron una gran devoción, entre ellos Teresa de Ávila, quien lo tomó como abogado e intercesor. En todos los libros de oraciones se encuentra alguna oración a san José. Invocaciones particulares que le son dirigidas todos los miércoles y especialmente durante todo el mes de marzo, tradicionalmente dedicado a él. Como descendiente de David de cuya raíz debía brotar Jesús según la promesa hecha a David por el profeta Natán y como esposo de María de Nazaret, san José es la pieza que une el Antiguo y el Nuevo Testamento

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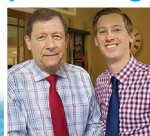
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
