SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

"You worry and fret about so many things, and yet few are needed."

Hospitality - an act or show of welcome - is a basic, practical, bodily doing of love. It is this deeply human way of friendship that is at the heart of the ways in which God comes to people in today's scripture readings.

Our world today is one where hospitality as a practice of love is much needed. Whether we look at our own cities and towns and the loneliness that is so often to be found there, or further away, to the refugees fleeing war and suffering, the many thousands of displaced people of our time—wherever we look, there is a call to share and befriend. Such a call is also a challenge, as it was for Martha.

We are not called to grand gestures or lavish actions that we can take some pride in as the giver or brilliant host. Rather, our giving should always, like Mary's, be centered on meeting the person whom we welcome. We need to learn to sit still with those we are called to care for, and listen to them, and let them know they are heard. Too often our fretting over too many things gets in the way of loving; busyness is only really godly when it is a practice of love.

In the week ahead let's recognize the moments of hospitality that are opened up to us: buying a coffee for a workmate - and then spending some time chatting over it with them; inviting someone new to our homes - and getting to know them better; giving some food or money to the street person - and stopping to talk and listening to his or her story. If our generosity keeps the love of that person central, these moments will surely also be moments of meeting God.
