SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

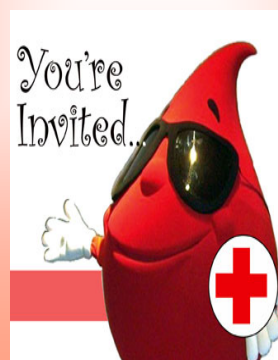

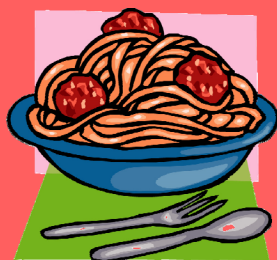

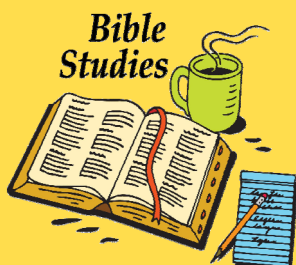

7. Rezar a Dios por los vivos y por los difuntos

Si de verdad lo hacemos con todo nuestro corazón, y nos dirigimos a Dios pidiendo por estas personas, estamos realizando una verdadera obra de misericordia espiritual. Esta obra de misericordia tiene un fundamento muy profundo, porque gracias a nuestro bautismo hemos sido “injertados en Cristo (cf. *Rm*6,5), empezamos a formar parte de su Cuerpo Místico.
