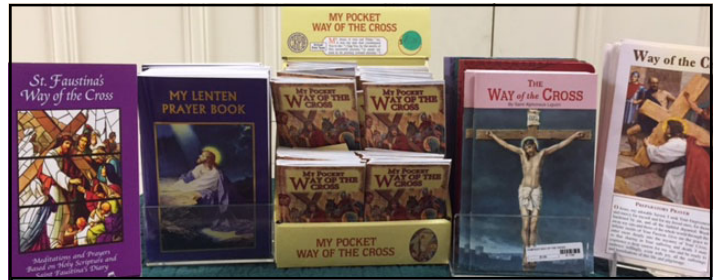

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

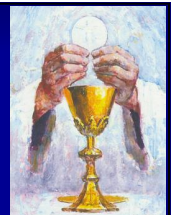

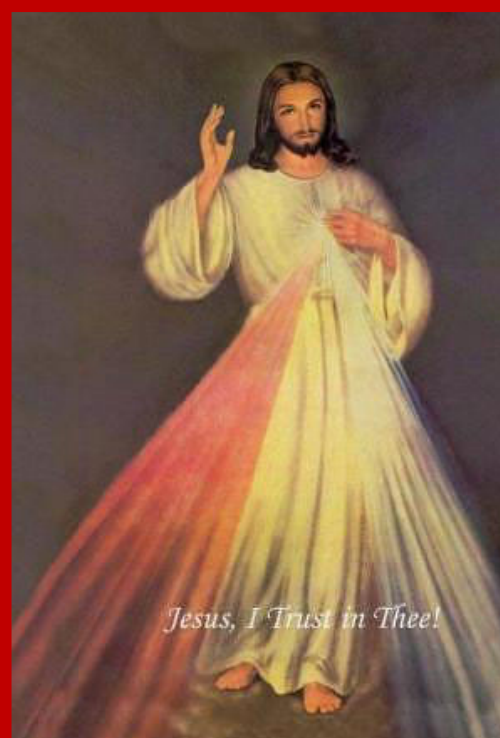

4. Dar posada al peregrino

La señal de Dios: un desalojado

"Y mientras estaban allí le llegó el tiempo del parto y dio a luz a su hijo primogénito, lo envolvió en pañales y lo acostó en un pesebre, porque no tenían sitio en la posada." (Lc 2,6-7) En el tiempo de Navidad escuchamos repetidamente que la señal de Dios, según el evangelio, es el desalojo, un niño envuelto en pañales y acostado en un pesebre porque no había alojamiento para él. Como le puede ocurrir a cualquier refugiado, perseguido, desahuciado, emigrante, transeúnte. Está clara la identificación de Dios con los que no tienen vivienda, con los que son "peregrinos del mundo y la historia", no hay duda de que es verdad que se ha hecho uno con ellos, y que por eso puede decir que lo que le hagamos a ellos se lo hacemos a Él. Mientras vamos de camino todos necesitamos sentirnos alojados y nos da miedo vivir en la intemperie, desalojados, sin techo, ser transeúntes sin referencia de hogar y de calor humano y familiar. La realidad nos muestra una muchedumbre ingente de desalojados en nuestra sociedad por motivos diferentes: En nuestro mundo hay 174 millones de migrantes con dirección al norte y 60 millones con dirección al sur, por razones y motivos variados. La persona entra en un estado de indefensión, en el que especialmente, necesita del amparo social y comunitario, la falta de éste hace que la persona se sienta desprotegida, desalojada y pueda llegar a experimentar la depresión y vacío existencial.

¿Cómo hacer una buena confesión y ganar la indulgencia jubilar?

1. Examen de conciencia. (El hijo pródigo examina su conciencia).
2. Dolor de los pecados y la contrición del corazón. (Se arrepiente).
3. Confesar todos los pecados. (Hace propósito de volver al padre).

5. Cumplir la penitencia. (Paga con buenas obras sus pecados)

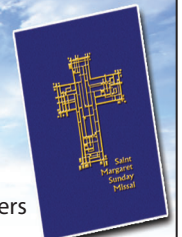
