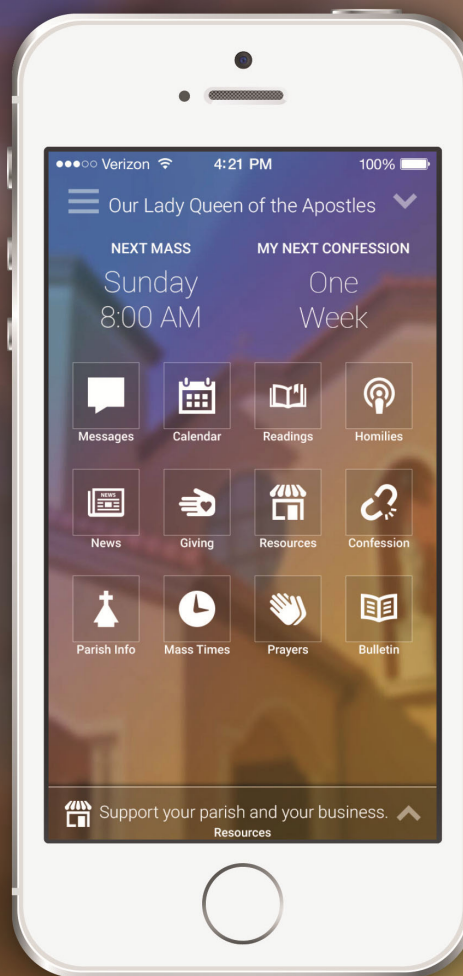

"We've Been Called"

"The Lord is kind and merciful"- Psalm 103 for 3rd Sunday of Lent

Compassionate love is behind all Jesus' activity, inspiring and shaping his whole life. For him compassion is not just another virtue, another attitude. His life is entwined with mercy; he aches with the people's suffering, makes it his own, and turns it into the central principle of his activity. He is the epitome of the "father" in the parable who, "filled with compassion," embraces the wayward son who comes back defeated and humiliated; or like the "Samaritan" who, "moved by pity," went to the aid of the man fallen by the wayside.

Jesus is clearly demolishing - with compassionate words and merciful gestures - any walls erected to separate us from one another. Jesus is always ready to tell everyone about the boundless compassion of his loving Abba. In Psalm 103 we read, "the Lord is kind and merciful...He pardons all our iniquities, heals all our ills. He redeems your life from destruction, crowns you with kindness and compassion."

As Pope Francis has said: "The mercy of God is not an abstract idea, but a concrete reality with which God reveals love as that of a father or a mother, moved to the very depths out of love for their child..."

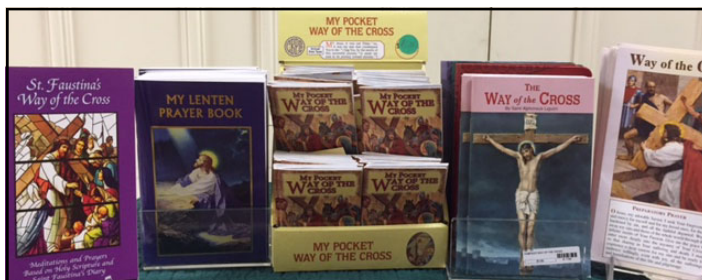

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice
each month. You need to come into the parish
office to register for class. Ideally, preparation
should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed
dates are given before approval by the priest. In
order to avoid disappointments, do not book
travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until
a confirmed date has been assigned at the
conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents
needing annulments of marriages, or those not
married, or those not married in the Church,
will be assisted in addressing those issues
before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a
supporting member of the parish for at least six
months prior to your marriage. The date should
not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish
office to inform us of anyone hospitalized,
homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

OPERATION RICE BOWL

One of the things we are called to do during Lent, is to **give alms**. One way this is accomplished is through the use of the rice bowl given to each child. Please encourage your child(ren) to participate fully in Operation Rice Bowl. Family participation is an even better way for the whole family to experience almsgiving during Lent.

1. **Keep the rice bowls at home until after Easter.**
2. **Return the money only, not the rice bowls.**
3. **Make checks payable to OLQA ("Rice Bowl" in memo).**

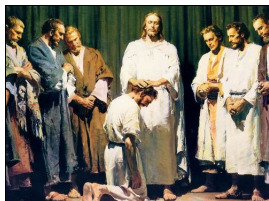
Stations of the Cross

2. Dar de comer al hambriento (continuación)

El "Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica", al comentar la petición del pan que hacemos en el Padrenuestro, afirma lo siguiente: "El drama del hambre en el mundo llama a los cristianos que oran en verdad a una responsabilidad efectiva hacia sus hermanos, tanto en sus conductas personales como en su solidaridad con la familia humana. Esta petición de la Oración del Señor no puede ser aislada de las parábolas del pobre Lázaro (cf. Lc 16,19-31) y del juicio final (cf. Mt 25,31-46)". Esa responsabilidad lleva a un trabajo concreto para que la producción y distribución de alimentos sea capaz de alimentar a todos, lo cual es posible desde una organización social justa y un auténtico compromiso de servir a los más necesitados (cf. Benedicto XVI, encíclica "Caritas in veritate" n. 27). Dar de comer al hambriento invita a trabajar a largo plazo por un mundo más solidario, al mismo tiempo que interviene en lo inmediato: a la ayuda a esta persona cercana que hoy no tiene para comer, a ofrecer donativos a Caritas, Caridades católicas, San Vicente de Paúl, Catholic Relief Services y a otros grupos que atienden a millones de personas que cada día buscan algo para saciar su hambre. Es una obra de misericordia que está al alcance de casi todos. Basta a veces un pequeño sacrificio, dejar de lado la propia comodidad, abrir los ojos y el corazón para sentir la necesidad de tantos hermanos nuestros, y acudir con sencillez y ternura para socorrerlos en una de sus necesidades básicas: la de la comida diaria.
