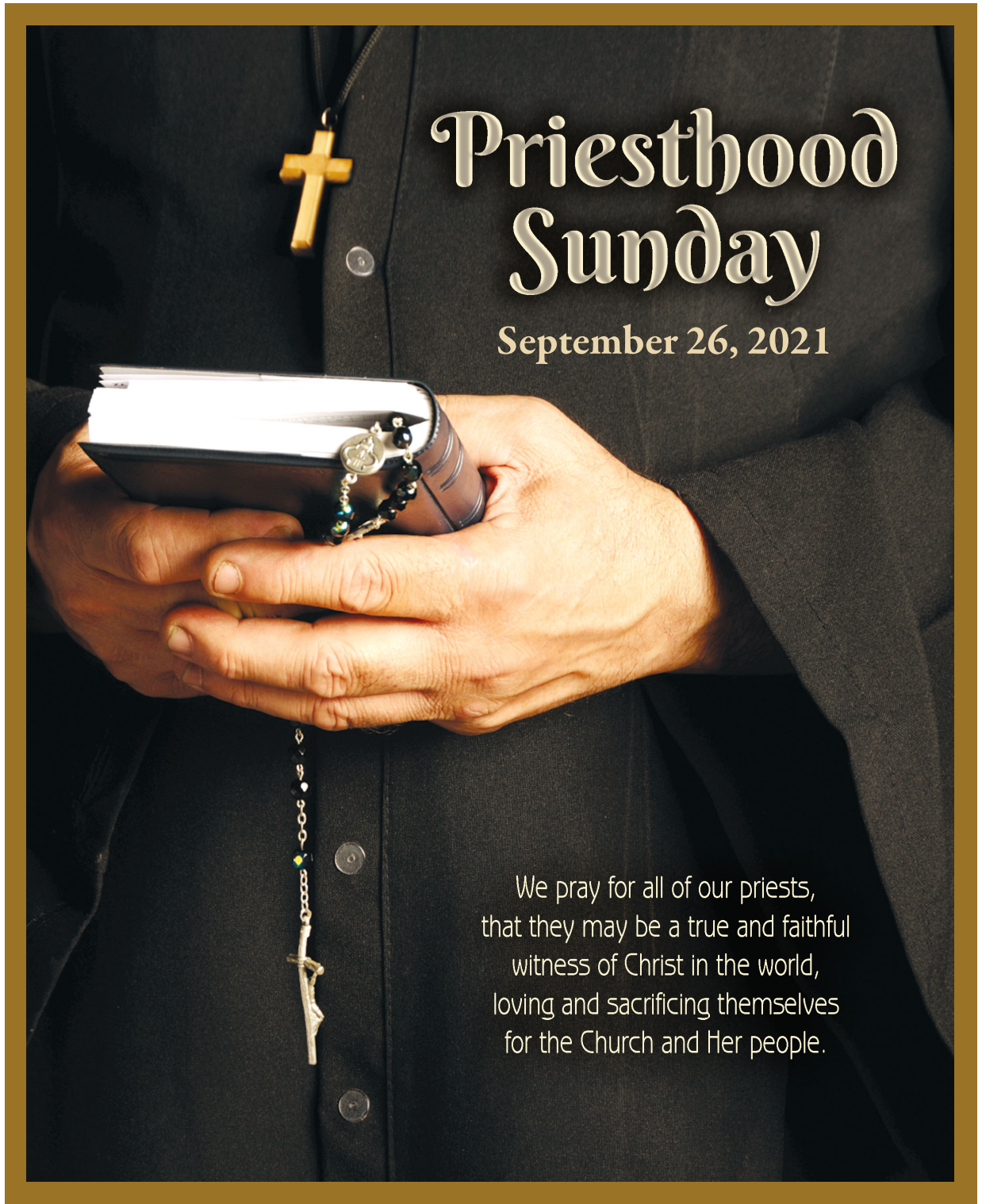

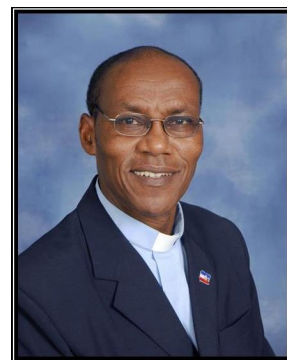
Mary, Queen of the Apostles, and Patroness of our Diocese, pray for us. AMEN.

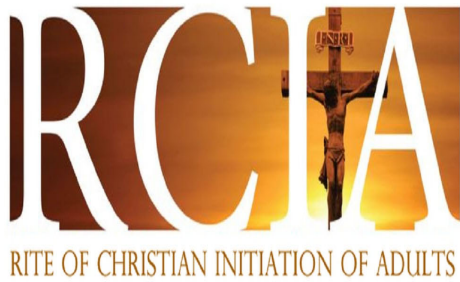
