

Sacramental Information



This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany. An ancient tradition has parishioners bringing home packets of blessed chalk, using the chalk to inscribe the initials of the legendary Three Kings over the doorway, and invoking their protection of the home. If you wish, a little donation made in their honor can be left in the basket containing the packets, as you take one packet per family.

The inscription over the doorway includes the new year, divided by the initials of the three kings: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar.




