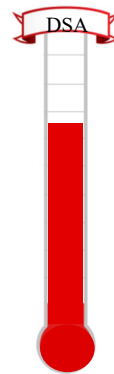

WANT TO LEARN MORE ABOUT YOUR CATHOLIC FAITH?

The School of Christian Formation for the Diocese of Palm Beach is offering a series of classes and programs for adult Catholics who wish to learn more about the rich traditions of their faith.

Each class meets from 7:15 to 9:15 on Wednesday evenings for a total of six classes (twelve hours) taught during the Fall and Spring Semesters. 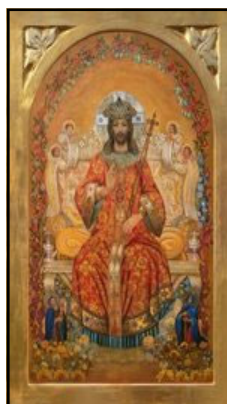

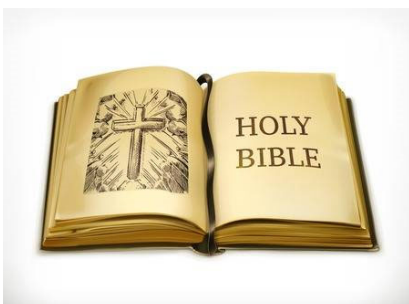

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “La Palabra de Jesús en el Evangelio está viva”

Quien da la homilía debe cumplir bien su ministerio, ofreciendo un servicio real a todos aquellos que participan en la misa, pero también cuantos la escuchan deben hacer su parte. Sobre todo prestando la debida atención, asumiendo las justas disposiciones interiores, sin pretextos subjetivos, sabiendo que todo predicador tiene méritos y límites. Si a veces hay motivos para aburrirse por la homilía larga o no centrada o incomprensible, otras veces sin embargo el obstáculo es el prejuicio. Y quien hace la homilía debe ser consciente de que no está haciendo algo propio, está predicando, dando voz a Jesús, la Palabra de Jesús. Y cuántas veces vemos que en la homilía algunos se duermen, otros hablan o salen fuera a fumar. Por esto, por favor, que sea breve, la homilía, pero que esté bien preparada. ¿Y cómo se prepara una homilía, queridos sacerdotes, diáconos, obispos? Con la oración, con el estudio de la Palabra de Dios y haciendo una síntesis clara y breve. La Liturgia de la Palabra, a través del Evangelio y la homilía, Dios dialoga con su pueblo, el cual lo escucha con atención y veneración y, al mismo tiempo, lo reconoce presente y operante. Si nos ponemos a la escucha de la «buena noticia», seremos convertidos y transformados por ella, capaces de cambiarnos a nosotros mismos y al mundo. ¿Por qué? Porque la Buena Noticia, la Palabra de Dios entra por las orejas, va al corazón y llega a las manos para hacer buenas obras.
