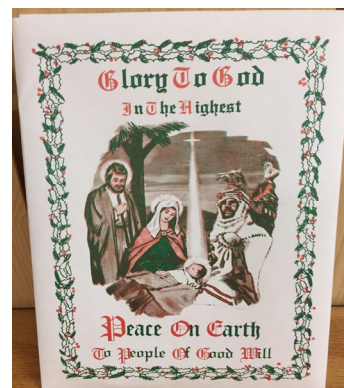

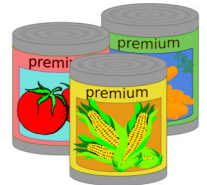

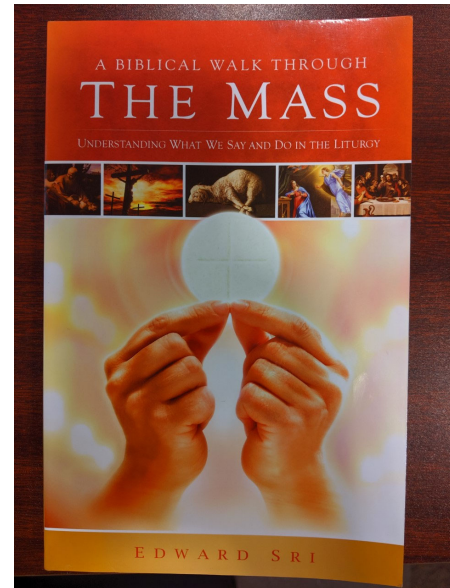

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “Salimos de la Iglesia para ir en paz”

Cada vez que salgo de la misa, debo salir mejor de como entré, con más vida, con más ganas de dar testimonio cristiano. A través de la eucaristía el Señor Jesús entra en nosotros, en nuestro corazón y en nuestra carne, para que podamos “expresar en la vida el sacramento recibido en la fe”. Celebramos la eucaristía para aprender a convertirnos en hombres y mujeres eucarísticos. ¿Qué significa esto? dejar actuar a Cristo en nuestras obras: que sus pensamientos sean nuestros pensamientos, sus sentimientos los nuestros, sus elecciones nuestras elecciones. Y esto es santidad hacer como hizo Cristo es santidad cristiana. Lo expresa san Pablo, hablando de la propia asimilación con Jesús, y dice así: “Con Cristo estoy crucificado: y no vivo yo, sino que es Cristo quien vive en mí” Pablo nos ilumina a nosotros: en la medida en la que mortificamos nuestro egoísmo, hacemos morir lo que se opone al Evangelio y al amor de Jesús, se crea dentro de nosotros un mayor espacio para la potencia de su Espíritu. Los cristianos son hombres y mujeres que se dejan agrandar el alma con la fuerza del Espíritu Santo, después de haber recibido el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. ¡Dejaos agrandar el alma! No estas almas tan estrechas y cerradas, pequeñas, egoístas, ¡no! Almas anchas, almas grandes, con grandes horizontes, dejaos alargar el alma con la fuerza del Espíritu tu, después de haber recibido el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo.
