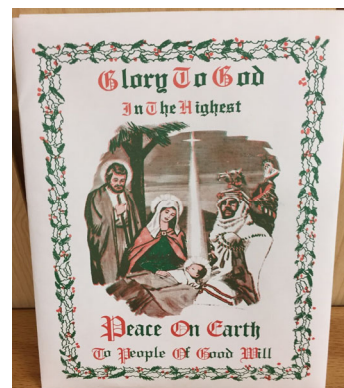

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: "Salimos de la Iglesia para ir en paz"

La eucaristía es custodiada en el tabernáculo para la comunión, para los enfermos y para la adoración silenciosa del Señor en el Santísimo Sacramento. Los frutos de la misa, están destinados a madurar en la vida de cada día. Podemos decir así, un poco forzando la imagen: la misa es como el grano de trigo que después en la vida ordinaria crece y madura en las buenas obras, en las actitudes que nos hacen parecernos a Jesús. En verdad, aumentando nuestra unión con Cristo, la eucaristía actualiza la gracia que el Espíritu nos ha donado en el bautismo y en la confirmación, para que nuestro testimonio cristiano sea creíble. Entonces, ¿la eucaristía qué hace? Nos separa del pecado: "Cuanto más participamos en la vida de Cristo y más progresamos en su amistad, tanto más difícil se nos hará romper con Él por el pecado mortal". Participar en la eucaristía compromete en relación con los otros, especial los pobres, educándonos a pasar de la carne de Cristo a la carne de los hermanos, en los que él espera ser reconocido por nosotros, servido, honrado, amado. Llevando el tesoro de la unión con Cristo en vasijas de barro necesitamos continuamente volver al santo altar, hasta cuando, en el paraíso, disfrutemos plenamente la bienaventuranza del banquete de bodas del Cordero. Demos gracias al Señor por el camino de redescubrimiento de la santa misa que nos ha donado para realizar juntos, y dejémonos atraer con fe renovada a este encuentro real con Jesús, muerto y resucitado por nosotros.
