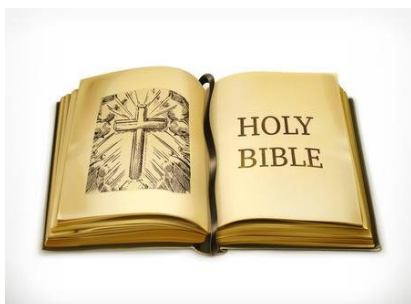

**Catequesis del Papa Francisco
sobre la Eucaristía:**

“Las ofrendas del pueblo santo”

La liturgia eucarística, en ella, a través de los santos signos, la Iglesia hace continuamente presente el Sacrificio de la nueva alianza sellada por Jesús sobre el altar de la Cruz. Fue el primer altar cristiano, el de la Cruz, y cuando nosotros nos acercamos al altar para celebrar la misa, nuestra memoria va al altar de la Cruz. El sacerdote, que en la misa representa a Cristo, cumple lo que el Señor mismo hizo y confió a los discípulos en la Última Cena: tomó el pan y el cáliz, dio gracias, los pasó a sus discípulos diciendo: «Tomad, comed... bebed: esto es mi cuerpo... este es el cáliz de mi sangre. Haced esto en memoria mía». Obediente al mandamiento de Jesús, la Iglesia ha dispuesto en la liturgia eucarística el momento que corresponde a las palabras y a los gestos cumplidos por Él en la vigilia de su Pasión. Así, en la preparación de los dones. son llevados al altar el pan y el vino, es decir los elementos que Cristo tomó en sus manos. En la Oración eucarística damos gracias a Dios por la obra de la redención y las ofrendas se convierten en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo. Siguen la fracción del Pan y la Comunión, mediante la cual revivimos la experiencia de los Apóstoles que recibieron los dones eucarísticos de las manos de Cristo mismo. Al primer gesto de Jesús: «tomó el pan y el cáliz del vino», corresponde por tanto la preparación de los dones. Es la primera parte de la Liturgia eucarística.....continúa
