



XVI Domingo Ordinario:¿Por interés o por amor?

El Evangelio de esta semana nos muestra a un Cristo que huye. No huye de la cruz sino de los aplausos. Y lo hace, porque sabe que no son sinceros sino interesados. No aplauden su mensaje, sino sus milagros. Y el Señor se va. A Jesús no le molesta que le pidamos cosas, sino que Su amor por nosotros es tan grande, que su mayor alegría es precisamente amarnos y ayudarnos. Pero porque nos ama de verdad, Él no está a gusto hasta que su ayuda no produce en nosotros los frutos deseados. No le busquemos sólo porque lo que vamos a obtener de Él, sino por Él mismo; no acudamos sólo a pedir, sino que vayamos también para dar y para agradecer. Un agradecimiento que vaya más allá de la cortesía, de las palabras educadas, pues a veces éstas son una excusa para quedar con la conciencia tranquila. Y si lo hacemos así, Él no huirá de nosotros, sino que nos admitirá en su compañía y nos llenará de sus dones.
