



THE PRESENTATION OF JESUS IN THE TEMPLE

Every February 2nd, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of The Lord Jesus in the Temple. In the Roman Catholic Church, the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple is the fourth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary. (This event is described in the Bible, Luke, 2:22-40). Simeon, a righteous man who lived in Jerusalem, promised by the Holy Spirit, he would not died before he sees Christ. The day that Joseph and Mary brought the infant Jesus in the Temple - according to customs and traditions of Jewish law, the rich would offer a lamb as sacrifice; but, Joseph and Mary were poor, they offered two Turtle doves (or pigeons) as sacrifice. Simeon was there, he saw the baby Jesus and held Him in his arms and praised God and said: "this child would bring salvation to all people. Lord, now let your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation which you have prepared in the presence of all people, a light for revelation to the gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel". (Luke 2:29-32).



A widow named Anna also saw the baby, that day, she knew who He was, gave thanks to God and told many people about Him.

Most people take a walk to think or clear their minds. But for Lent, you can now pray while walking. May you walk by faith and grow stronger spiritually and physically as you spend time with your Heavenly Father. Keep track of your physical movement at home, at the mall, or at the gym, each day, while reflecting on Scripture. You can find suggestions for reflection on the parish website: OLQA.cc. If you are not mobile, prayers count for miles! Twenty minutes of prayer, which is about the length of a Rosary, chaplet, or morning Mass is equivalent to one mile.


