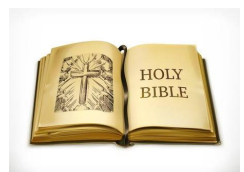

Dear Parishioners,

This past fiscal year, July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019, was a very good year financially for our parish. Although our offertory income fell short of budget by \$21,410, we were still better than last year by \$21,880. This was directly attributed to our Increase Offertory Program in late 2017. Most of our parishioners fulfilled their commitment in increasing their offertory contributions. Our offertory is our major source of income, and as our offertory remains strong, we can continue to meet the needs of our parish. As you can see from the parish financial statements published this week, our parish debt decreased by \$124,500 and our current assets increased by \$28,744. These are very positive results.

In addition, we were very fortunate to have been able to complete various major projects around the church. We invested in upgrading our church sound system. In addition, we upgraded our classrooms by installing the appropriate technology to assist our catechists in sharing their faith with our PREP students, replacing worn and torn carpeting and adding youth appropriate furniture as needed. We were also able to complete the upgrade to the pavilion with the addition of the awning that now wraps the pavilion and painting the floor covering many years of use. (Thanks to the Knights of Columbus who paid for and completed the painting) We also upgraded one classroom transforming it into a music room which also is a very comfortable place for our Bereavement Ministry to meet. All this was possible because of donations made by a group of parishioners who wanted to sponsor these important projects. We were also fortunate that a parishioner donated the funds for the purchase of a multi-passenger golf cart for our Parking Lot Ministry. This cart is meant to, not only assist families, handicapped and elderly get from the parking lot to the church, but also patrols the parking lot during Masses adding more security to our campus.

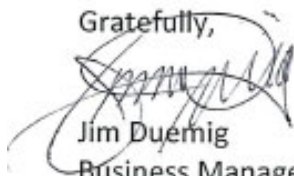
This fiscal year, we are faced with additional projects that need our attention which will impact our financial position. The parking lot needs to be sealed and re-stripped and many of the parking stops that are broken need to be replaced. In addition, we need to protect our investment of all our pavers and have them sealed. The pavilion and Celebration Hall need to be painted and we are closely monitoring our video system in the church which will need to be replaced within the next 12-18 months. This will cause extraordinary pressure on our operating

budget therefore, by the recommendation of our Finance Committee, we are forecasting to reduce principal payments on our parish debt over the next 12 months.

Our financial reports are on the following two pages. We remain committed to being good stewards of the financial gifts you have entrusted us with. If you have any questions, please feel free to email me to jim@olqa.cc or call me at 798-5661 ext. 112.

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “Las ofrendas del pueblo santo”

Una imagen de este movimiento oblato de oración se representa en el incienso que, consumido en el fuego, libera un humo perfumado que sube hacia lo alto: incensar las ofrendas, como se hace en los días de fiesta, incensar la cruz, el altar, el sacerdote y el pueblo sacerdotal manifiesta visiblemente el vínculo del ofertorio que une todas estas realidades al sacrificio de Cristo (cf. IGMR, 75). Y no olvidar: está el altar que es Cristo, pero siempre en referencia al primer altar que es la Cruz, y sobre el altar que es Cristo llevamos lo poco de nuestros dones, el pan y el vino que después se convertirán en el tanto: Jesús mismo que se da a nosotros. Y todo esto es cuanto expresa también la oración sobre las ofrendas. En ella el sacerdote pide a Dios aceptar los dones que la Iglesia les ofrece, invocando el fruto del admirable intercambio entre nuestra pobreza y su riqueza. En el pan y el vino le presentamos la ofrenda de nuestra vida, para que sea transformada por el Espíritu Santo en el sacrificio de Cristo y se convierta con Él en una sola ofrenda espiritual agradable al Padre. Mientras se concluye así la preparación de los dones, nos dispones a la Oración Eucarística (cf. ibíd., 77). Que la espiritualidad del don de sí, que este momento de la misa nos enseña, pueda iluminar nuestras jornadas, las relaciones con los otros, las cosas que hacemos, los sufrimientos que encontramos, ayudándonos a construir la ciudad terrena a la luz del Evangelio.
