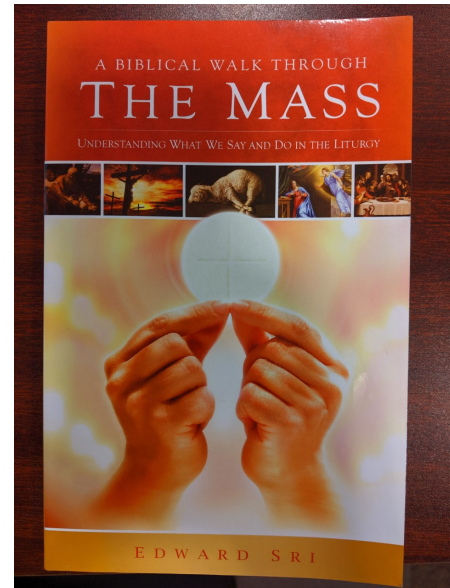

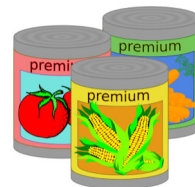

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “Salimos de la Iglesia para ir en paz”

Con esta catequesis concluimos el ciclo dedicado a la misa, que es precisamente la conmemoración, pero no solamente como memoria, se vive de nuevo la Pasión y la Resurrección de Jesús. Una vez finalizada la oración después de la Comunión; la misa se concluye con la bendición impartida por el sacerdote y la despedida del pueblo. Como se había iniciado con la señal de la cruz, en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, se sella de nuevo en el nombre de la Trinidad la misa, es decir, la acción litúrgica. Sin embargo, sabemos que mientras la misa finaliza, se abre el compromiso del testimonio cristiano. Los cristianos no van a misa para hacer una tarea semanal y después se olvidan, ¡no!. Los cristianos van a misa para participar en la Pasión y Resurrección del Señor y después vivir más como cristianos: se abre el compromiso del testimonio cristiano. Salimos de la iglesia para «ir en paz» y llevar la bendición de Dios a las actividades cotidianas, a nuestras casas, a los ambientes de trabajo, entre las ocupaciones de la ciudad terrenal, «glorificando al Señor con nuestra vida» Pero si nosotros salimos de la iglesia charlando y diciendo: «mira esto, mira aquello...», con la lengua larga, la misa no ha entrado en mi corazón. ¿Por qué? Porque no soy capaz de vivir el testimonio Cristiano.....continúa
