### **Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “Nadie es olvidado”**

El sacerdote dice: “Misterio de la fe” y nosotros respondemos con una aclamación. Celebrando el memorial de la muerte y resurrección del Señor, en la espera de su regreso glorioso, la Iglesia ofrece al Padre el sacrificio que reconcilia cielo y tierra: ofrece el sacrificio pascual de Cristo ofreciéndose con Él y pidiendo, en virtud del Espíritu Santo, de convertirse “en Cristo, un solo cuerpo y un solo espíritu” La Iglesia quiere unirnos a Cristo y convertirse con el Señor en un solo cuerpo y un solo espíritu. Y esta es la gracia y el fruto de la Comunión sacramental: nos nutrimos del Cuerpo de Cristo para convertirnos, nosotros que lo comemos, en su Cuerpo viviente hoy en el mundo.
