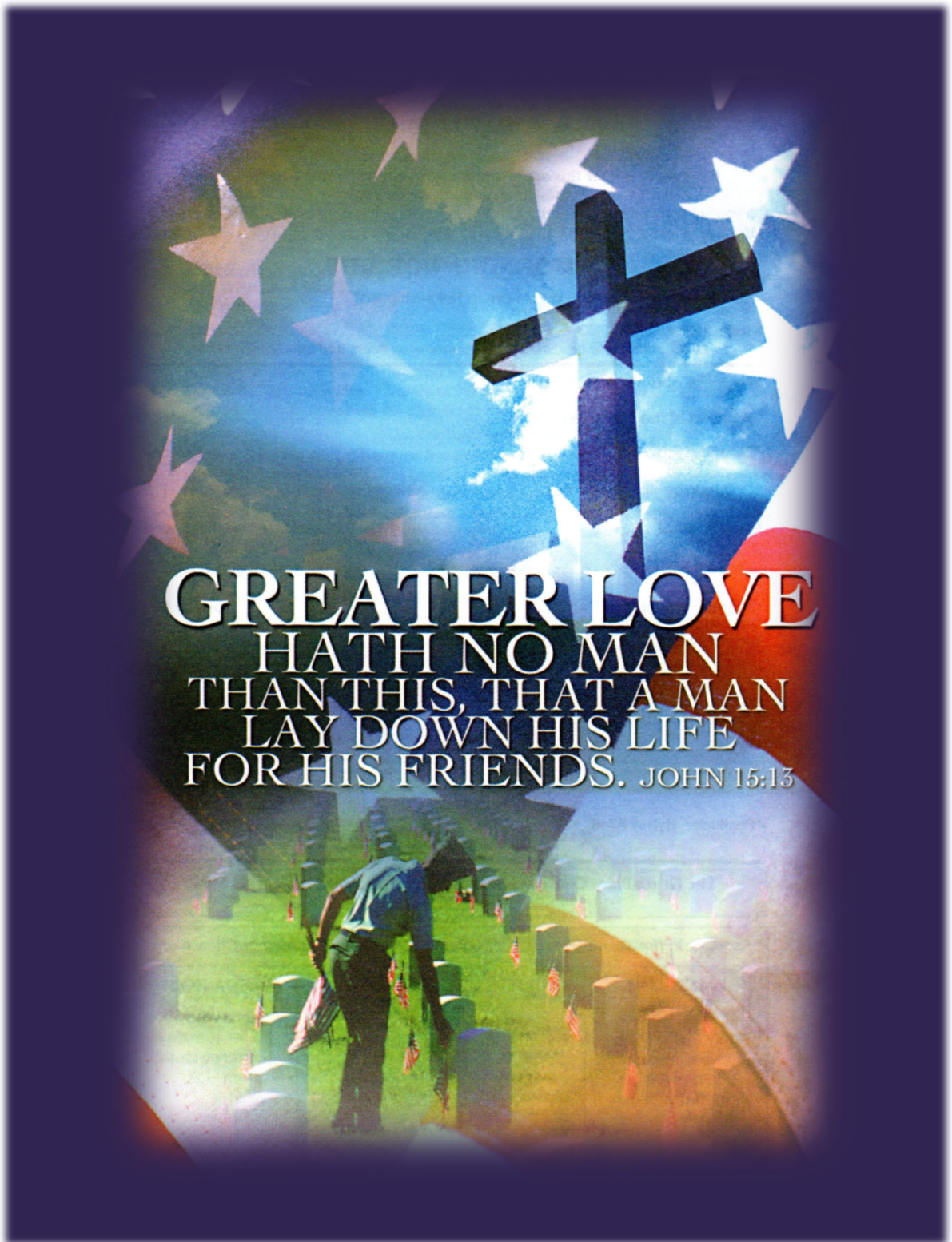

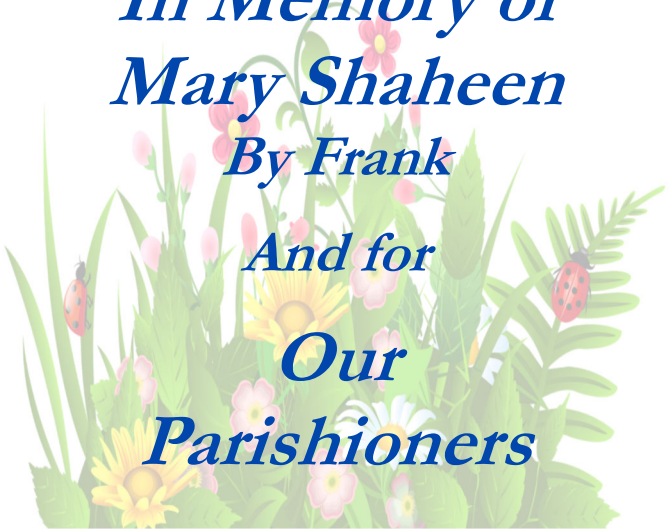

About this weekend's mission appeal...

The Archdiocese of Owerri is one of the 56 dioceses in Nigeria. It is under the pastoral leadership of Archbishop Anthony Obinna. The archdiocese has a Catholic population of about 1.1 million. Though the missionaries arrived in the area in 1912, it was created a diocese in 1950. There are 370 indigenous priests and about 500 seminarians at various levels of formation for the priesthood. Recently the government handed back schools it had confiscated from the church after the 1967-1970 civil war. Today the local church is focusing on revamping these schools and establishing new ones to assure solid educational and moral foundation in the youth. Besides education, the diocese also provides other services to the general public including health care and charitable services to the indigent population through its EuCare (Eucharistic Care) program.

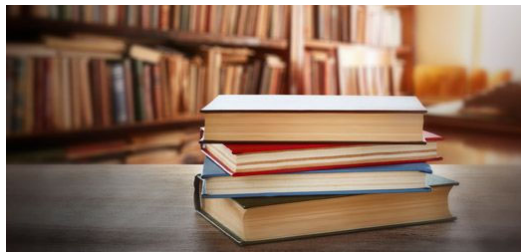

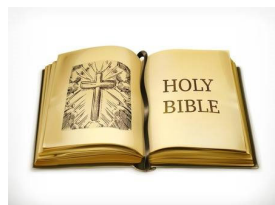

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: "Gloria a Dios en el cielo"

Del encuentro entre la miseria humana y la misericordia divina toma vida la gratitud expresada en el «Gloria», «un himno antiquísimo y venerable con el que la Iglesia, congregada en el Espíritu Santo, glorifica a Dios Padre y glorifica y le suplica al Cordero» (Ordenamiento General del Misal Romano, 53). La introducción de este himno —«Gloria a Dios en el cielo»— retoma el canto de los ángeles en el nacimiento de Jesús en Belén, alegre anuncio del abrazo entre cielo y tierra. Este canto también nos involucra reunidos en la oración: «Gloria a Dios en el cielo y en la tierra, paz a los hombres que ama el Señor». Después del «Gloria», o cuando este no está, la oración toma forma particular en la oración denominada «colecta», por medio de la cual se expresa el carácter propio de la celebración. Con la invitación «oremos», el sacerdote insta al pueblo a recogerse con él en un momento de silencio, con el fin de tomar conciencia de estar en presencia de Dios y hacer emerger, a cada uno en su corazón, las intenciones personales con las que participa en la misa. El sacerdote dice «oremos»; y después, viene un momento de silencio y cada uno piensa en las cosas que necesita, que quiere pedir en la oración (escuchar otras voces: la de nuestro corazón y, sobre todo, la voz del Espíritu Santo. En la liturgia, la naturaleza del sagrado silencio depende del momento en el que tiene lugar....continuará
