Meditation from "With You Always" By Rev. Francis X. Gaeta :

In today's Gospel, Jesus is telling us that his religion isn't a religion at all, but is rather a way of living according to the call of God that flows from our hearts. We are authentic when our actions and thoughts and attitudes flow from the authenticity that we have achieved through faith and our personal relationship with Jesus.

We are holy by how we think, live, and treat others. Our holiness is not just conditioned on following a daily rule book, but on what we do each day to ourselves and to other people.

Externals can be wonderful. Fasting, prayer schedules, etc., are all very helpful after we have first established and accepted a personal and loving relationship with Jesus in which all the parts of our hearts are open to the touch and the rule of the Good Shepherd. We realize then that the externals have no power in themselves, but only as they express and celebrate the interior relationships we have with the Lord.

Holiness consists in knowing and loving Jesus Christ in a completely open and honest manner in which every part of us is given to him and we hold nothing for ourselves. This process of acquiring the mind and heart of Jesus takes a lifetime. But when we are honest in the process, when we truly seek him, then it is much more likely that what will come from our hearts is love, mercy, tenderness and compassion.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

2014-15 Financial Report

This past year was an interesting year concerning our financial position. We started off very slowly and in fact made an agreement with the Diocese that we would pay interest-only on our mortgage debt for our church for an entire year. We experienced many obstacles with air conditioners, bad weather during our Festival, driving income down, and other issues that negatively affected our financial position. At the same time, our offertory was not growing to meet our needs, and our savings were depleting. As you know we implemented an Offertory Increase Program which has been very successful and has helped turn our financial position significantly. In fact, we expect that the full impact of the program will result in \$100,000 addition to our annual offertory. We are in a better position today and we have built our reserves to \$155,000. This will enable us to cover our mortgage payments during the summertime when offertory is down and we don't have additional income as we do throughout the rest of the year. We will continue to work on reducing expense where appropriate and continue to drive other income sources (Hall Rental for example) to continue to solidify our financial position.

The following reports are the financials for the previous year as well as our budget forecast for 2015-16 Fiscal Year. The concern that doesn't appear in the forecast though, is our 2015 Diocesan Service Appeal. We are currently approximately \$48,000 short of our Commitment. If you haven't made your 2015 DSA Gift yet, please do so. As you know the parish is required to cover our shortfall.

We would like to thank all of you for your continued support and generosity to our parish. In addition, once again, we want to thank all of you who responded to our request and increased your offertory gift. If you didn't respond to that request yet and you have the financial resources to increase your giving it would be greatly appreciated. Without the generosity of our parishioners to the Offertory request we would not be in this favorable position.

We would like to thank the continued efforts and guidance of our Finance Committee.
