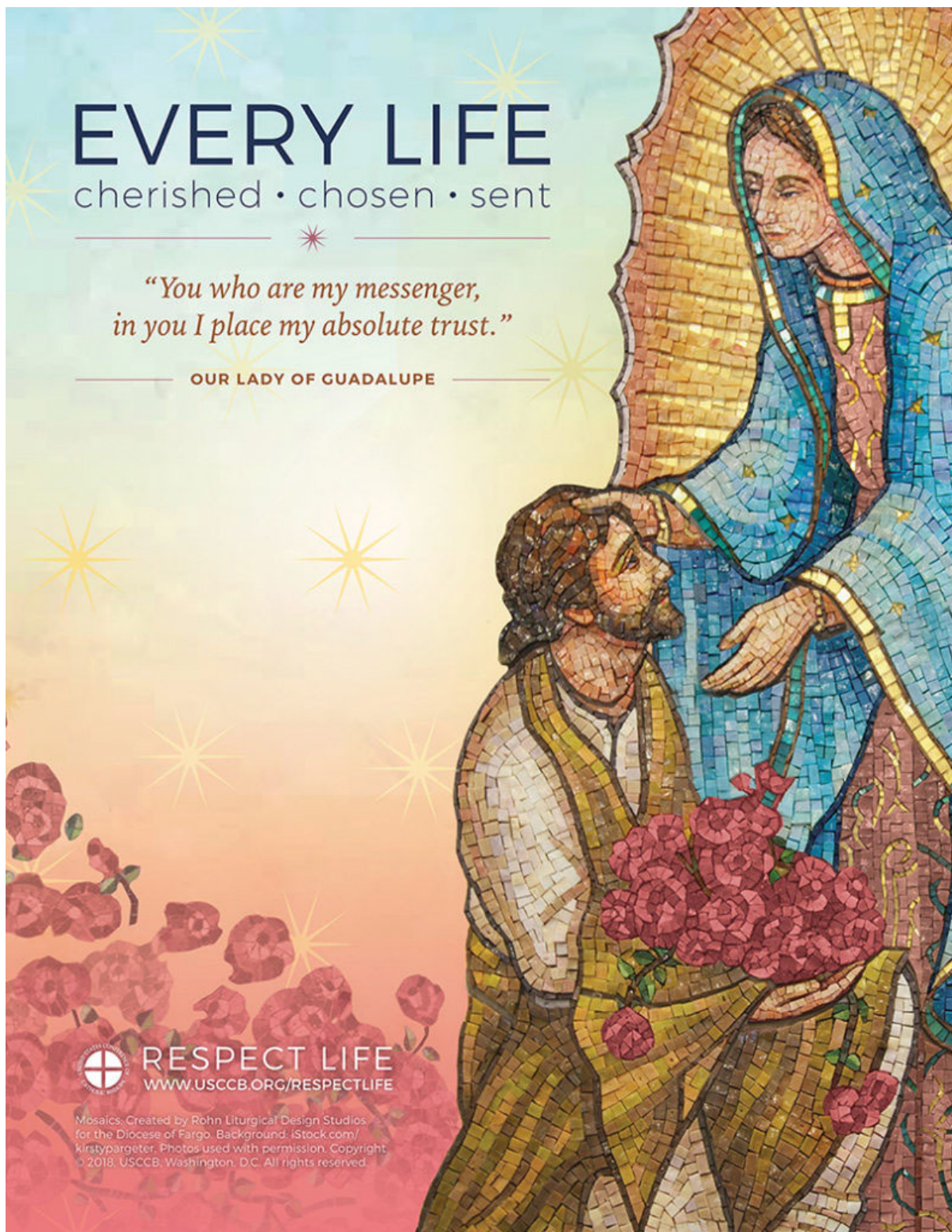

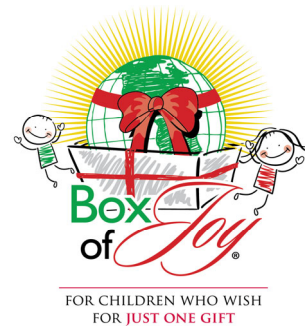

The Health and Wellness Ministry Presents... Health Insurance

Choosing a health insurance plan can be complicated. Knowing just a few things before you compare plans can make it simpler.

The 4 "metal" categories: There are 4 categories of health insurance plans: Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum. These categories show how you and your plan share costs. Plan categories have nothing to do with quality of care.

Your total costs for health care: You pay a monthly bill to your insurance company (a "premium"), even if you don't use medical services that month. You pay out-of-pocket costs, including a deductible, when you get care. It's important to think about both kinds of costs when shopping for a plan.

Plan and network types — HMO, PPO, POS, and EPO:

Some plan types allow you to use almost any doctor or health care facility. Others limit your choices or charge you more if you use providers outside their network.

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “Dichosos los invitados al banquete de bodas del Cordero”

Es una invitación que alegra y juntos empuja hacia un examen de conciencia iluminado por la fe. Si por una parte, vemos la distancia que nos separa de la santidad de Cristo, por la otra, creemos que su Sangre viene «esparcida para la remisión de los pecados». Todos nosotros fuimos perdonados en el bautismo y todos nosotros seremos perdonados cada vez que nos acercamos al sacramento de la penitencia. Y no os olvidéis: Jesús perdona siempre. Jesús no se cansa de perdonar. Somos nosotros los que nos cansamos de pedir perdón. Precisamente pensando en el valor salvador de esa Sangre, san Ambrosio exclama: “Yo que peco siempre, debo siempre disponer de la medicina”. En esta fe, también nosotros queremos la mirada al Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo y lo invocamos: “oh, Señor, no soy digno de que entres en mi casa: pero una palabra bastará para sanarme”. Esto lo decimos en cada Misa. Si somos nosotros los que nos movemos en procesión para hacer la comunión, nosotros vamos hacia el altar en procesión para hacer la comunión, en realidad es Cristo quien viene a nuestro encuentro para asimilarnos a él. ¡Hay un encuentro con Jesús! Nutrirse de la eucaristía significa dejarse mutar en lo que recibimos..... continúa
