Sacramental Information

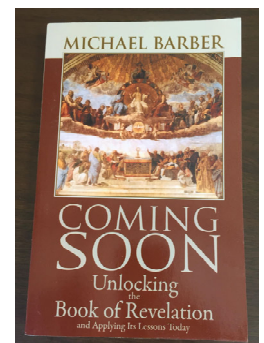

Catequesis del Papa sobre la Eucaristía: la Eucaristía transfigura todo nuestro ser.

¿Qué es esencialmente la misa? La misa es el memorial del Misterio pascual de Cristo. Nos convierte en partícipes de su victoria sobre el pecado y la muerte y da significado pleno a nuestra vida. Por esto, para comprender el valor de la misa debemos ante todo entender entonces el significado bíblico del «memorial». Jesucristo, con su pasión, muerte, resurrección y ascensión al cielo llevó a término la Pascua. Y la misa es el memorial de su Pascua, de su «éxodo», que cumplió por nosotros, para hacernos salir de la esclavitud e introducirnos en la tierra prometida de la vida eterna. No es solamente un recuerdo, no, es más: es hacer presente aquello que ha sucedido hace veinte siglos. La eucaristía nos lleva siempre al vértice de las acciones de salvación de Dios: el Señor Jesús, haciéndose pan partido para nosotros, vierte sobre vosotros toda la misericordia y su amor, como hizo en la cruz, para renovar nuestro corazón, nuestra existencia y nuestro modo de relacionarnos con Él y con los hermanos. Participar en la misa, en particular el domingo, significa entrar en la victoria del Resucitado, ser iluminados por su luz, calentados por su calor. A través de la celebración eucarística el Espíritu Santo nos hace partícipes de la vida divina que es capaz de transfigurar todo nuestro ser mortal. Y en su paso de la muerte a la vida, del tiempo a la eternidad, el Señor Jesús nos arrastra también a nosotros con Él para hacer la Pascua... (continúa la próxima semana)
