

Please call or stop by the parish office and we will be happy to get you started. Travel plans for out of town guests should not be made until a date for the baptism is confirmed by the parish staff. A meeting with a priest *may* be required. We look forward to hearing from you.

Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: We are blessed to have a group of volunteers in our parish who are happy to bring Holy Communion to the sick, the hospitalized and the homebound. Please call the parish office to make arrangements. If you or your loved one would like for a priest to visit with the Sacrament of Anointing, please do not hesitate to call us.

No matter what our vocation - parent, religious, single person, etc. -we, like the apostles in today's Gospel, need time by ourselves to be recreated so that we will have something worthwhile to give our family, neighbors and friends.

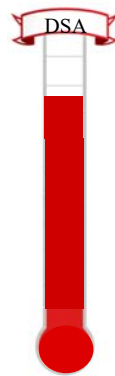

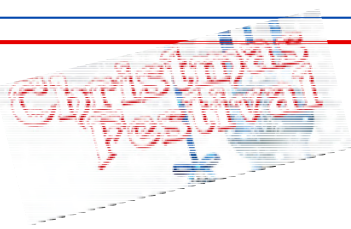

XVI Domingo Ordinario: Ora et labora

Jesús, con su ejemplo personal, con sus palabras y con lo que hizo hacer a sus apóstoles, nos está dando un mensaje lleno de equilibrio y madurez humana. Ese mensaje nos dice que es imprescindible y urgente trabajar, pero que es imposible hacerlo si no se está lleno de fuerza y de decisión, para lo cual es fundamental encontrar tiempo para estar con Él, que es la fuente de toda gracia, de toda fuerza, de toda motivación generosa. El mundo nos espera para oír el anuncio del Evangelio, para recibir de nosotros un buen testimonio, para levantar al caído, construir la paz, vestir al desnudo o consolar al triste. Pero ¿cómo vamos a ser capaces de hacer todas esas cosas tan difíciles y generalmente agotadoras, si estamos secos por dentro?. Por eso, el Señor quiso que nos nutriéramos de Él, verdadera fuerza y verdadero alimento. Si eres dado a un extremo -tanto si es el trabajo como si es la oración-, piensa que el verdadero camino católico es el equilibrio, la madurez. O dicho de otro modo: el camino de Cristo es el amor, pues ese es el mandamiento que nos dejó el Señor. Pero no sólo se ama cuando se reza o no sólo cuando se trabaja. Así pues, reza y trabaja. Ama siempre, cuando rezas y cuando trabajas. Reza por amor y trabaja por amor.
